SIX YELLOW ROBIN AWARD WINNERS AVAILABLE ON IFFR UNLEASHED

IFFR OFFERS ONLINE ALTERNATIVE FOR CANCELLED
CURAÇAO IFFR 2020

Due to covid-19 circumstances, the 9th edition of Curaçao IFFR (CIFFR), scheduled for 21 to 26 April 2020 in Willemstad, has been cancelled. To continue to offer visibility to filmmakers from the Caribbean region, IFFR has made six previous winners of the Yellow Robin Award available to watch online in Curaçao and the Benelux until 12 May 2020.

Ever since its launch in 2013 at the second edition of CIFFR, the Yellow Robin Award Competition has served as the festival's major platform for upcoming filmmaking talent from the region.

Festival director IFFR Vanja Kaludjeric: "The Yellow Robin Award Competition serves as a launch pad for participating filmmakers to gain access to the wider international film scene. Their personal stories are of great value and enrich the cinema IFFR stands for."

Each year, an international jury decides which filmmaker receives the \$10,000 prize. On top of that, the winning film goes on to screen at the next editions of both IFFR and Mexico's Morelia International Film Festival.

Separate films cost €4,50. It's also possible to watch three films of choice for only €12, or all six for only €22.50.
