Eindhoven, 19th February 2016

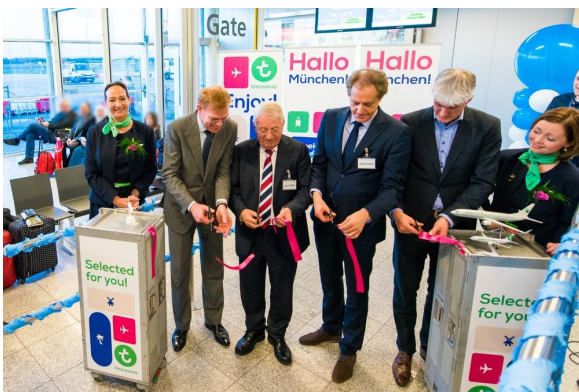
Today at 18:45hrs marked the departure of the first Transavia flight between Eindhoven Airport and Munich Franz Josef Strauss airport.

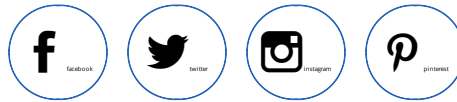
