Certification validates PR.co's information security management system and strengthens trust for listed companies, governments, and enterprise communications teams using its PR software platform.

PR.co was certified on 9 June 2026 by Brand Compliance B.V., following an independent audit of its Information Security Management System. The certification marks an important milestone in PR.co's ongoing investment in security, privacy, compliance, and operational resilience. It demonstrates that PR.co has implemented a structured, independently audited framework for managing information security risks across its people, processes, technology, and platform operations.

For PR and communications teams, information security is business-critical. PR software is often used to manage sensitive corporate announcements, embargoed news, unpublished financial information, crisis communications, stakeholder data, media relationships, and reputation-sensitive materials. A security incident involving these assets can have legal, financial, regulatory, and reputational consequences.

"From embargoed announcements to crisis communications and listed-company disclosures, our customers need to know that their communications infrastructure is secure, reliable, and professionally governed. Achieving ISO/IEC 27001 certification is an important external validation of the security program we have been building for years."

ISO/IEC 27001 certification confirms that PR.co operates an Information Security Management System designed to identify, assess, treat, monitor, and continually improve how information security risks are managed. The certification covers the organizational, technical, and procedural controls that support the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of information handled by PR.co.

“Security is not a one-time project or a checklist,” added **Jeroen Bos**. “It is an ongoing responsibility. ISO/IEC 27001 gives our customers additional confidence that PR.co treats information security as a core part of how we operate, build, monitor, and improve our platform.”

The achievement is especially relevant for enterprise and public-sector customers that require formal vendor assurance, security documentation, and evidence of mature information security governance during procurement and ongoing supplier reviews.
