

Kevin Chappell secures his first PGA TOUR win at TPC San Antonio with a complete set of TaylorMade metalwoods

Kevin Chappell's playoff victory at the Valero Texas Open marks his first career PGA TOUR win and the 22nd win for TaylorMade drivers this season across worldwide Tours.



Using a powerful combination of his M1 driver and M1 fairway woods off the tee, Chappell became victorious in the Lone Star State after finishing with an impressive 4.383 Strokes Gained: Off The Tee. Even more striking was his confident final-round performance, wrapping things up with 71.43% driving accuracy on Sunday.

What You Need To Know:

- The win earned Chappell his first PGA TOUR victory
- Including Chappell, 7 of the top-10 finishers played TaylorMade metalwoods
- Chappell had 6 runner-up finishes before this week

- This was Chappell's first win in 180 starts
- Chappell tested all metalwood manufacturers after last year's Tour Championship; chose TaylorMade after a week of testing with his coach
- Moves to 21st in the 2017 FedExCup Standings
