

Brian Harman Closes with Back-to-Back Birdies to Capture Wells Fargo Championship in Thrilling Finish

Harman's 2nd career PGA TOUR victory is yet another for Team TaylorMade as brand's momentum continues to dominate on Worldwide Tours

Using a combination of M2 driver and M2 fairway woods, Harman finished 3rd in Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee and T7 in driving accuracy, highlighted by a 92.86% driving accuracy in the final round. With a thrilling birdie putt on the 72nd hole to take the outright lead, Harman's 10-under par held up to earn him the win over a slew of the world's best players, including stablemate Dustin Johnson, who finished T2.
