

# Team TaylorMade's Justin Rose Mounts Improbable Comeback to Capture WGC-HSBC Champions

Powered by a bag filled with TaylorMade clubs and golf ball, Rose cards final round 67 to erase 8-shot deficit, matches the third-largest comeback victory in PGA TOUR history.



## What You Need To Know:

- Rose's victory is the 29th on worldwide tours for TaylorMade's new '17 drivers, far outpacing the next closest manufacturer.
- This was the ninth win this season for the new TP5/TP5X ball. Dustin Johnson, Si-Woo Kim, Jon Rahm and Xander Schauffele have also won this year with the new golf ball.
- The win is Rose's eighth victory on the PGA TOUR.
- The eight-stroke deficit to claim victory is a career-best for Rose and a World Golf Championships record.
- Rose plays a combo set with a P790 4-iron and 5-PW in the P730 "Rose Proto". His shafts are KBS Tour C-Taper 125S+
- Rose's victory is his second World Golf Championships win for Rose, who also won the 2012 Mexico Championship
