

Major trial run of digital traffic platform during the Gentse Feesten

Starting July 19th, TMaaS, developer of the digital traffic platform for the City of Ghent, will be carrying out a major trial run of its virtual dashboard.

The trial run, driven by the Mobiliteitsbedrijf of the City of Ghent, will be carried out during the Gentse Feesten. The 10-day festival attracts a huge number of visitors every year and is a major challenge in terms of mobility, so it provides an ideal opportunity to put the dashboard to the test.

From the Gentse Feesten to the Winterfeesten

During the internal trial run, TMaaS will test the effectiveness and user-friendliness of the system. A dedicated team will set up the virtual dashboard in the 'control room' of the City of Ghent. By analyzing and visualizing traffic flows, TMaaS will be able to detect problems and irregularities and provide assistance to traffic managers during the festivities.

After the Gentse Feesten, TMaaS will evaluate the dashboard and continue developing it. Before the system's public launch as planned in spring of 2020, a second trial run is to be conducted during the Winterfeesten in December.
