A WORD FROM THE ORGANISATION

It is in a complex environment that the teams of the EcoTrail® the de Paris have prepared this 9th edition, but also in the difficulty they have drawn the energy required to guarantee the initial project, namely: Offer true cross-country races that highlight the territory of the Ile de France but also the values of authenticity and sharing held by practitioners. It will also be the 2nd consecutive year in which the Verticale de la Tour Eiffel to opens the event program, a glimpse at the to the vertical kilometre now offered by many Trail events with the unique character that the Eiffel Tower gives this unique event.

The EcoTrail® of Paris Ile de France is pursuing its development and this year is again looking forward to hosting more than 12,000 people who will also realize that the City can also accommodate genuine cross-country races!

THURSDAY MARCH 17: LA VERTICALE DE LA TOUR EIFFEL®

This ascent race of the 1,665 steps of the Eiffel Tower® - in a super-fast race format, timed, on the model of an against the clock (ski race, for example) - is a real sporting challenge.

It is also an exciting challenge because unlike other international staircase races, it unfolds with breathtaking views of Paris and in the open.

In 2015, for its first edition, la Verticale de la Tour Eiffel® welcomed 61 participants from 16 countries representing all disciplines of running (road, trail, path, staircase race ...). This year, the event has grown and gathered together more than 450 entries with 23 nationalities represented, 1/3 more than last year and will host 100 veteran athletes: 40 international elite athletes selected by a committee of international experts running, 50 amateur athletes drawn 10 athletes selected by the organization (as a wildcard).


This year the EcoTrail® de Paris and the Destination Nature Show have joined together to offer Nordic walking and hikes on Sunday, March 20, 2016.

THE HIKES BY DESTINATIONS NATURE

The Hikes of the EcoTrail® de Paris by Destinations Nature represent the will of the organizers to make the event accessible to the greatest number. Four walking distances will be offered on Sunday: 13km, 15km, 18km and 26km.



THE NORDIC WALKS BY DESTINATIONS NATURE

More sporting than «Hikes», the Nordic walks are practiced at a fast pace and with specific sticks for this discipline, their main characteristic being therefore walk with four limbs. Three distances are offered, 13,19 and 24 kilometres for three different speeds depending on the pace of leader (4 to 6 km / h); many choices of ways to discover or rediscover the Île-de-France.



Organized around 6 major pillars, EcoTrail® of Paris shows its exemplary and strength to mobilize its eco-players by offering innovative solutions, and sharing expertise of its teams environmentally responsible organizer partners, organizers, service, athletes, participants and volunteers. After COP 21, Thierry BRAILLARD, Secretary of State for Sports Isabelle AUTISSIER, President of WWF France, have presented the «Compendium of outstanding and innovative initiatives of French sport to fight against climate change.» The EcoTrail of Paris® was present among its exemplary initiatives.

By participating in the EcoTrail of Paris® each person makes the commitment to setting an example and :

RESPECTING LA NATURE

- FOCUS ON FRIENDLY TRANSPORT (public transport, cycling, carpooling, car sharing ...) for moving about.
- **AVOID WASTE,** over packaging, over-consumption (food, paper, equipment ...). Ex. Gourde et non bouteille plastique.
- **RESPECT THE SOIL** carefully following the path laid out by the organizers, which implies not cutting across paths so as to preserve traversed sites.
- Do not throw anything on the ground, RESPECT THE WILDLIFE.
- PARTICIPATE in sorting waste.
- USE PRIORITY toilets available.
- Reduce your impact on the environment through **SIMPLE AND CONCRETE GESTURES** of everyday life.
- SENSIBILISER les autres participants, les spectateurs et votre entourage aux ÉCO-GESTES.
- To make other participants, spectators and others aware of environmentally **FRIENDLY PRACTICES**.
