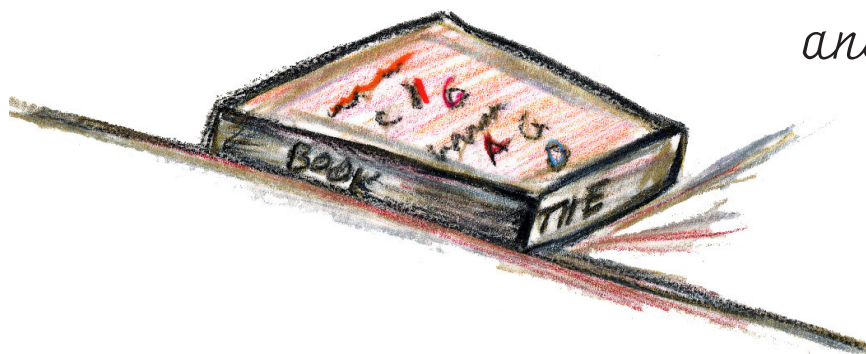


In the heart of the Musical Forest,

life flowed with laughter.*





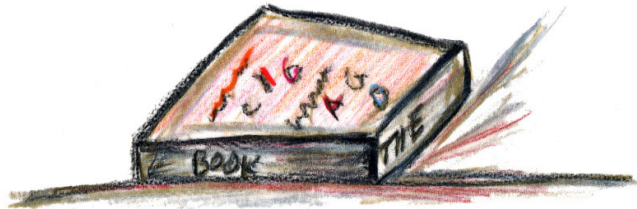
After the

for many, many years”



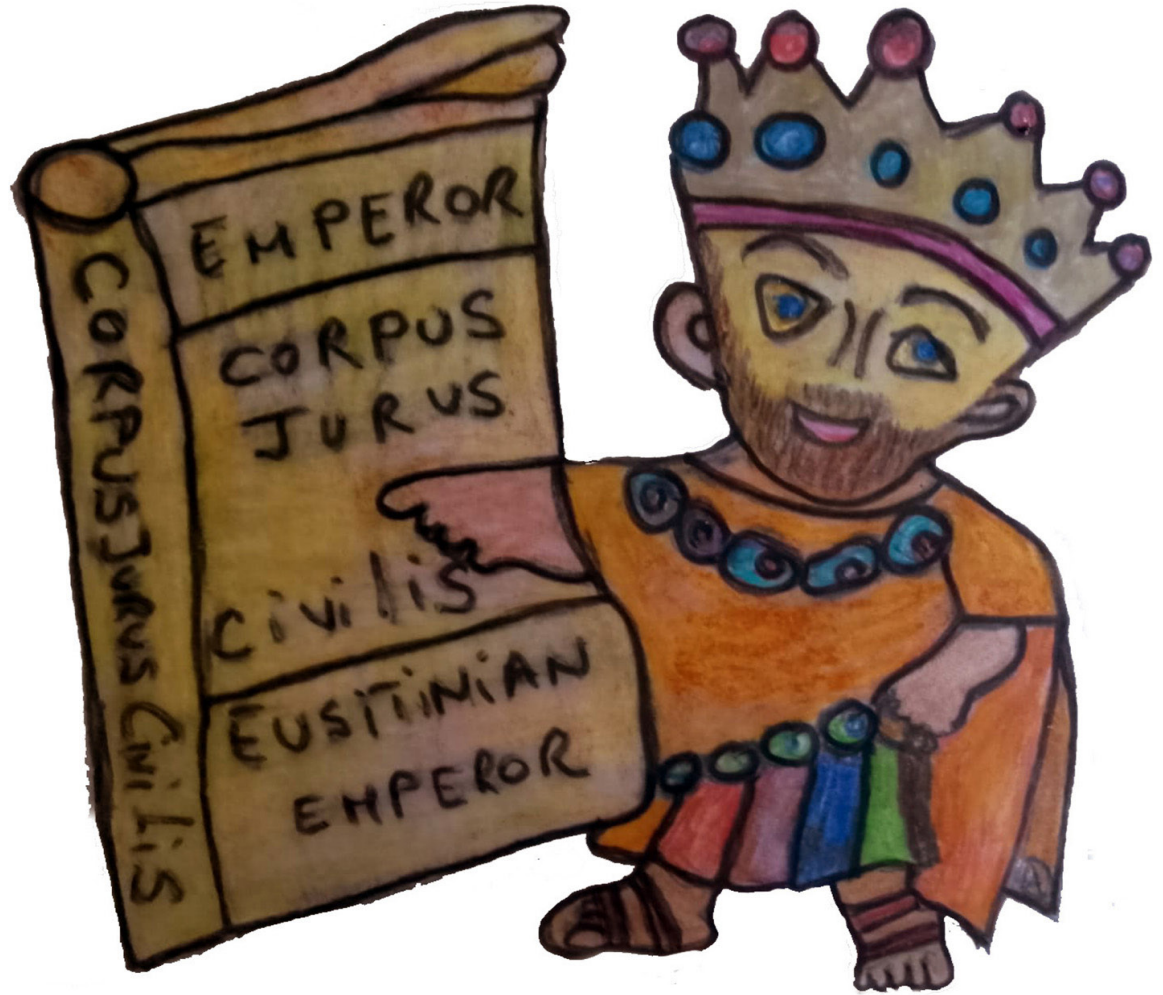
Different places

without reason.



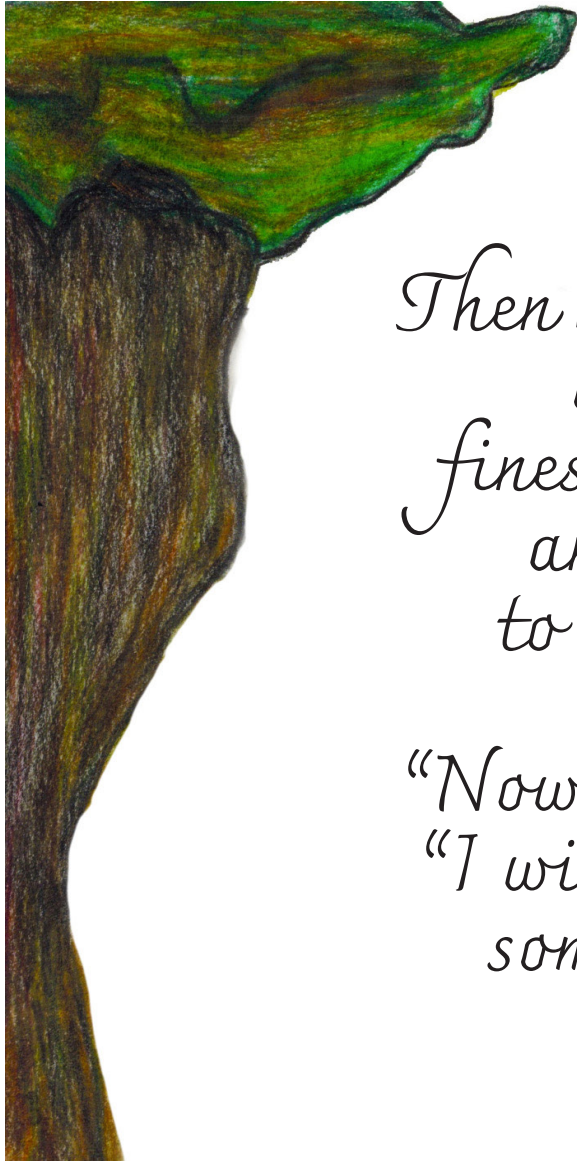
*That way, we care for the forest

something”.



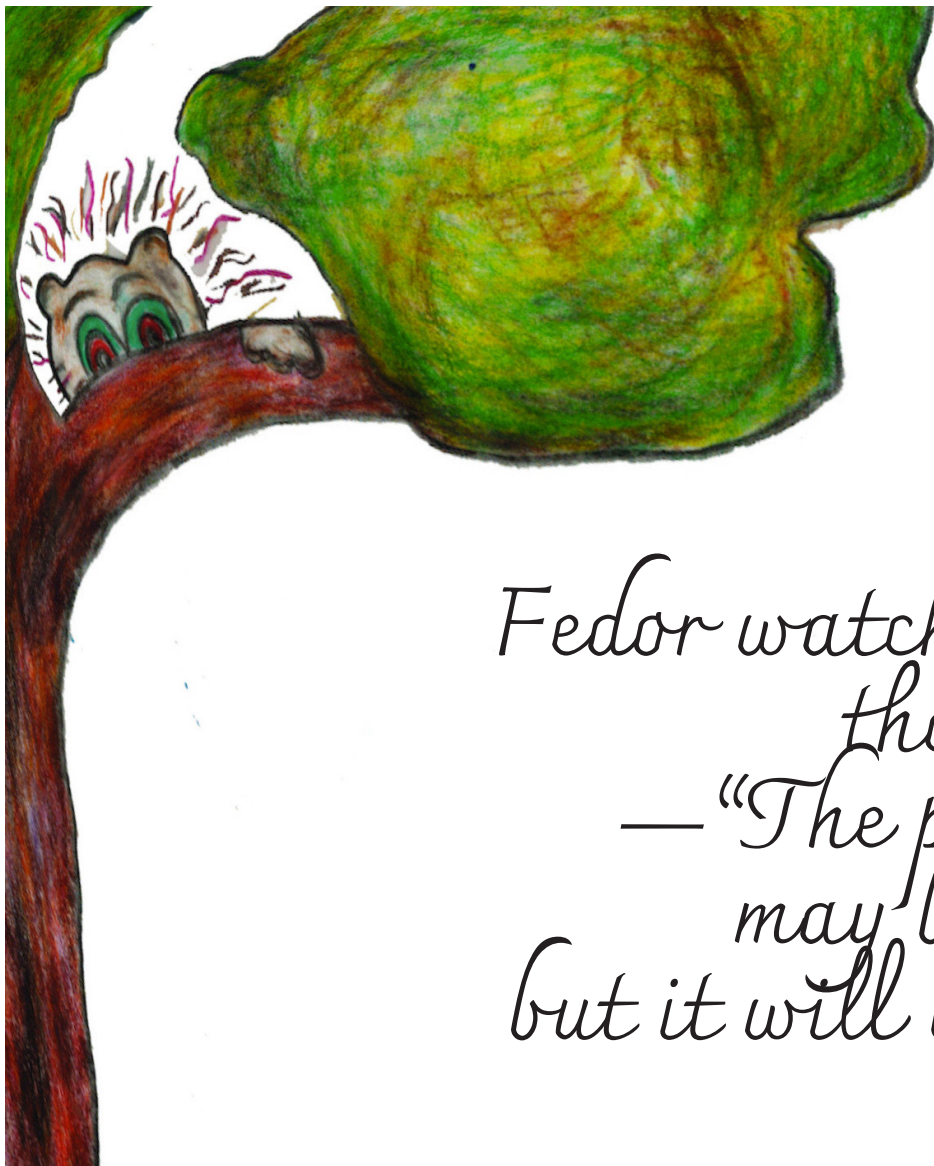
Ballad of the Roman Woman

played along.



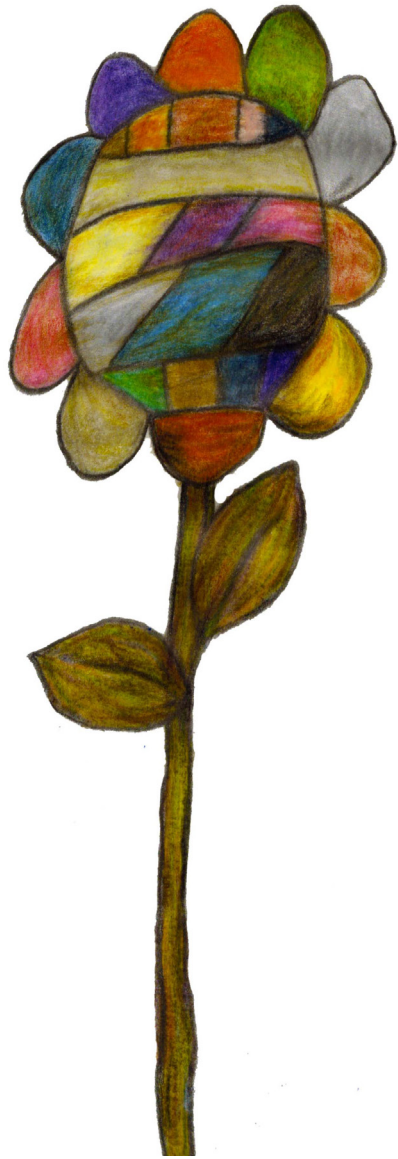
Fedor watched quietly and
