## GoFundMe Hero: 13-Year-Old Girl Starts Trend of Using GoFundMe to Take Young People to See Oscar-Nominated Hidden Figures

More than 70 campaigns have raised \$120k to help kids to see the inspiring film

Redwood City, California | February 22, 2017 — People across the United States are fundraising on GoFundMe to take young people to see box office sensation *Hidden Figures*. The film tells the inspiring story of African American women who worked as human computers during the early days of human space flight at NASA. After going to a screening of the movie at the White House, Taylor Richardson, a 13-year-old from Jacksonville, FL, started [one of the first campaigns](#) to take girls in her community to see *Hidden Figures* in theaters.

Not only has Taylor's campaign raised over \$17,000, she also helped start the trend of over 70 GoFundMes for people in other communities to go to the movie.
