- The 2,374 square foot lab features the lab space, meeting space, 5G solution showcase & demonstration space

- Secure, holding station for luggage, bags, and other materials for visiting partners

This investment signifies our commitment to innovation on Guam and will transform the way we communicate and engage with the world around us.


