

Boijmans Next Door

During the forthcoming renovation and modernisation of Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen, the collection remains visible and accessible in Rotterdam. Some 500 masterpieces will be displayed in eleven special exhibitions at eight neighbouring institutions under the title **Boijmans Next Door**. The exhibitions in these guest venues will create encounters between Boijmans' collection and that of its neighbours.

16 March 2019 – 17 January 2021

Tax and Customs Museum: **'Forged Together: Masters in Silver'**

A selection of Dutch silver goblets, tobacco boxes and salt cellars are exhibited alongside old master paintings in which the same objects are depicted.

2 June 2020 - 29 November 2020

Chabot Museum: **'Art Represents Everything'**

This exhibition brings together Expressionist artists from around the world, from the pioneers of Expressionism to post-war movements such as CoBrA and Abstract Expressionism.

4 September 2020 – 9 January 2022

Wereldmuseum: **'Remix Rotterdam. Boijmans x Wereldmuseum'**

Unknown histories will be revealed in this exciting combination of historical and contemporary design, ethnographic objects and visual art.

Erasmus Medical Centre: **'Human Appearances – Strength & Vulnerability'**

The human body is central both to this institution and to this selection of sculptures, with amongst others Auguste Rodin's Pierre de Wissant.

Art history and maritime history come together in this exhibition of model ships and sublime seascapes from the sixteenth to the twenty-first century.

The Kunsthal kicks off the Boijmans Next Door project with exquisite, colourful prints by the famous Spanish artist Pablo Picasso.

Stedelijk Museum Schiedam: **'Rothko & Me'**

How does it feel to be completely alone with Rothko's painting 'Grey, Orange on Maroon, No. 8' from 1960? You can find out for yourself in the exhibition 'Rothko & Me'.

19 March – 1 September 2019

Chabot Museum: **'Branding Rotterdam'**

An exhibition about the artists' group 'De Branding' (The Surf), an important link in the development of modern art in the Netherlands in the years 1917-26.
