Exclusive Interview with Sofiane Sehili, winner of the Atlas Mountain Race 2020

Morocco, 21st February 2020 - Both male and female winners of the inaugural Atlas Mountain Race have crossed the line in Morocco. Sofiane Sehili, winner of the 2019 Inca Divide adds another title to his Palamares while komoot ambassador Jenny Tough took convincing command of the race early on to be the first female across the line today.

Three days, 21 hours and 50 minutes. That's the amount of time it took Sofiane Sehili to cover 1,145 kilometers of rough Moroccan terrain, becoming the overall winner of the inaugural PEDALED Atlas Mountain Race. Komoot was given a rare opportunity to get inside the head of a rider within days of managing such a feat, we asked Sofiane some questions about Morocco, and the overall experience of ultra-endurance racing.

Sofiane described to komoot how he is currently feeling, both physically and mentally.

“Physically I'm exhausted. My lips are burnt, my butt's all fried, my toes are sore. I'm having trouble standing up or sitting down. I've lost feeling in my fingertips. And I have a few scratches that testify to the deplorable state of the tracks. Mentally, on the other hand, I'm super happy. Almost euphoric”
