Komoot launches the Expedition Alay route - a new off-road bikepacking adventure in Kyrgyzstan

Potsdam May 2nd - Adventure platform komoot launches a second bikepacking route with expert route-builders Tristan Bogaard and Belén Castelló, following the launch of the Zillertal Trail in July 2022. Expedition Alay takes riders through Kyrgyzstan, over high-altitude mountain passes, across rivers and through truly wild landscapes. With around 8,000 m of ascending over the 500 km loop, this is a bucket list route for the most adventurous bikepackers.

The route is now available to all as a komoot Collection, and adds to komoot's ever growing resource of over 300 bikepacking adventures across the world.

Expedition Alay

The new 500 km route was born out of Tristan & Belén's personal fascination with this particular corner of Central Asia. They searched wide and far to create a route that would connect the city of Osh and the Alay Valley, meandering through some of Kyrgyzstan's most spectacular scenery.

Expedition Alay is the result; a stunning new bikepacking route far from the beaten track, tackling two epic high-altitude mountain passes along the way.

Kyrgyzstan is a country of unlimited bikepacking potential. Everywhere you go, wild mountains emerge in different sizes and colors, nature sprawls and shows its calming yet captivating power. Expedition Alay offers a unique look at an often overlooked part of the country; the south-western Alay mountains. Our loop guides you through three remote river valleys. You'll wade through rivers and push over passes, and will live an unforgettable adventure.

A route for the most adventurous of bikepackers

The Expedition Alay route has been designed with the experienced bikepacker in mind; with a likely completion time of 12-14 days and consecutive days without resupply. While most of the route is rideable on a sturdy bike with wide tyres, there are sections of hike-a-bike and a good level of fitness will make life considerably easier. With around 8,000 m of ascending, there is no shortage of climbing. Riders tackling this route should be comfortable at high altitude, experienced wild campers and be confident mechanics.


