FRIEDRICHSHAFEN, Germany (Apr. 21, 2026) The [Cessna SkyCourier](#) is on display this week at AERO Friedrichshafen, marking the aircraft's debut at the show. The twin-engine, high-wing turboprop is featured at static display SD-62.

The Cessna SkyCourier is a twin-engine, high-wing turboprop designed to support air freight, commuter and special mission operations around the world. The aircraft is offered in freighter and passenger variants, along with optional kits that allow the aircraft to be configured from passenger to freighter, or in a Combi configuration.

- High wing design for improved ground clearance and loading access
- Freighter variant capable of handling up to three LD3 shipping containers with a 6,000 pound payload capacity
- 19 passenger variant with large cabin windows for natural light and views

- Two crew doors and a large side door for cargo loading or passenger boarding, depending on configuration
- Garmin G1000 NXi avionics
- Maximum cruise speed of more than 200 ktas
