#### **Meet Michael Rambo**

Michael Rambo, director of Textron Aviation Defense Operations & Training, served in the US ROTC for a year before attending the Air Force Academy from 1993-1997. He then served 11 years on active duty and 10 years in the Air Force Reserve before retiring in 2018.

While on active duty, Michael was a KC-135 pilot and served on the Air Education and Training Command's T-6A Texan II East Coast Demonstration Team. His logbook features nearly 500 combat hours and more than 3,000 flight hours across a broad spectrum of aircraft, including the Cessna T-37B Tweet, Raytheon T-1A Jayhawk, Beechcraft AT-6E Wolverine and more than 1,000 hours across the full range of Beechcraft T-6A/B/C/D Texan II aircraft.



Today, Michael reflects on what the holiday means for him.

"Veterans Day is sacred ground, a day of celebration focused on our Veteran community," said Michael. "It is a tribute to those who have made sacrifices for our nation — and each other — to uphold those values and principles for which our nation stands. It is a celebration of all those who have, will, or are currently serving, and those who support them."
