Fireside Chat | Food for thought

AMAL CLOONEY

Amal Clooney is an award-winning human rights lawyer who represents victims of genocide and sexual violence, and has helped free journalists arbitrarily detained for their work. She is a Professor of Practice in International Law at Oxford's Blavatnik School of Government and an Honorary Fellow of St Hugh's College, Oxford. Amal co-founded the Clooney Foundation for Justice, which provides free legal aid to defend free speech and women's rights in over 40 countries. Its work has led to dozens of journalists being released and thousands of women receiving legal support to protect their rights, including freedom from abuse and child marriage. In 2022, the Foundation partnered with the Obama Foundation's Girls Opportunity Alliance and Melinda French Gates to advance gender equality and combat child marriage. It also runs a fellowship for young women lawyers in Africa pursuing careers in human rights.

ALBERT RÖSTI

He has been Head of the Federal Department of the Environment, Transport, Energy and Communications since 1 January 2023

Albert Rösti was born in 1967 and grew up in Kandersteg. He was elected to the Federal Council in the first round of voting on 7 December 2022. He holds a doctorate in technical sciences and is an agronomist engineer and completed an MBA in Bern and Rochester NY. Before his election to the Federal Council, he was the owner of a company active in the fields of public affairs and project management. Albert Rösti was elected to the Swiss Federal Parliament in 2011. He was President of the Swiss People's Party (SVP) from 2016 to 2019. Federal Councillor Rösti will present the Prix Suisse in the field of business to entrepreneur Willy Michel.





PRIX SUISSE 2025

The Prix Suisse will be awarded for the fifth time on the evening of 8 November. The winners of the annual award are personalities who have made outstanding contributions to Switzerland in recent years. They are characterised by courage, innovative spirit and creativity.

Internationally, these people are among the top personalities in their field by international standards. They are role models for today's and future generations. Their work contributes significantly to the success and positive image of Switzerland.

The jury of the Swiss Initiative has nominated Willy Michel for the Prix Suisse 2025. At a festive ceremony, he will be honoured for his outstanding achievements and great services as a visionary, innovator, entrepreneur and patron. The prize will be presented by Federal Councillor Albert Rösti.

WILLY MICHEL

Visionary, innovator, entrepreneur & patron

Willy Michel is a visionary entrepreneur and innovator who fundamentally changed the medical technology industry with his companies Disetronic and Ypsomed. His pioneering work, particularly in the field of insulin delivery, has improved the lives of millions of people worldwide. At the same time, he strengthened Switzerland's position as a leading centre for precision, innovation and excellence in medical technology. Michel has also provided entrepreneurial impetus and left a lasting mark

in other areas such as pharmaceuticals, watchmaking, catering and art. His commitment to diabetes research and to cultural and social projects demonstrates a holistic understanding of responsibility. With courage, strategic vision and innovative strength, he is a role model for cross-generational entrepreneurship - one of the most versatile personalities in the Swiss economy with international appeal.
