

Learning to See Through a Blindfold: Superminds Academy - MindSee Lands in New York on June 6th

Superminds Academy - MindSee introduces families to blindfold-based perception exercises through a playful workshop built around the idea that focus and intuition can be trained like a muscle.

Combining sensory games, blindfolded exercises, and collaborative challenges, this 90-minute experience invites children and parents to work together through activities built

around focus, trust, and teamwork.

Taking place in a carefully guided environment, families navigate color-based puzzles, tactile games, object-sorting challenges, and communication exercises, all designed to encourage concentration and shared attention. Participants are guided by trained facilitators as they move through increasingly engaging sensory activities that challenge the way they communicate and collaborate.

At Superminds Academy - MindSee, parents are not spectators. Instead of waiting on the sidelines, adults actively participate alongside their children throughout the experience. Through spoken guidance, observation, and teamwork, families work together to complete each challenge without relying on sight, transforming ordinary problem-solving into a meaningful shared experience.

What begins as a playful sensory exercise quickly evolves into something deeper: an opportunity for families to slow down, communicate differently, and strengthen trust through cooperation and curiosity.

A Hands-On Workshop Built Around Focus, Communication, and trust

Superminds Academy - MindSee is structured as a progression of guided sensory activities that encourage children to practice concentration in an engaging and supportive environment. Sessions begin with simple 2D tasks involving colors, patterns, and numbers before evolving into more complex 3D exercises using cups, tactile objects, sorting games, and fine motor challenges.

As the experience unfolds, participants rely increasingly on verbal communication and teamwork to complete each activity. Blindfolded exercises encourage children to listen carefully, process instructions, and approach unfamiliar tasks with patience and confidence.

Throughout the session, parents and children experience each challenge together, creating moments of collaboration that extend beyond the workshop itself. The experience encourages families to reconnect through shared attention, communication, and problem-solving in an environment free from screens and distractions.
