Bengals roar into Kansas City looking to gain Super Bowl spot.

The Cincinnati Bengals and Kansas City Chiefs return to the AFC Championship Game for the second consecutive year. The Chiefs will play host to the Bengals – again -- on Sunday at Arrowhead Stadium. Kickoff is 6:30 p.m. ET.

The team is surging and is balanced on both sides of the ball. Defensive coordinator Lou Anarumo’s defensive game plan was outstanding.

“Joe Burrow is always relaxed and mellow. He never loses his cool. He thrives when he's under pressure and the team needs him. The Bengals are hot right now and are close to getting a back-to-back Super Bowl appearance in their QB's second year in the league. This is huge for the franchise.” Johnson concluded.

The Bengals went from being the underestimated team to having everybody on the edge of our seats. They've won as many playoff games in the last 2 seasons as the franchise did in 55 years and are now real Super Bowl contenders.
