Who is favored to win the US Open 2026?

As of this writing, Jannik Sinner is the favorite to win the 2026 US Open title. Fans may recall that the Italian sensation was forced to withdraw due to illness in last year's US Open finals against his young nemesis, Carlos Alcaraz, who was crowned the champion.

What do +200 odds mean?

Moneyline odds are commonly used for tennis, and many other sports for that matter, and +200 is an example of that. Any number with a plus (+) sign before it means the bettor will profit more money than they are risking if the bet is successful. In this case, a \$100 wager will profit \$200 if the bet is successful for a total return of \$300 (\$100 investment + \$200 profit = \$300).

What are the odds for Alcaraz to win the US Open?

As many tennis fans know, Carlos Alcaraz has been sidelined since April with a wrist injury. He has not competed in any tournaments, including this year's French Open and Wimbledon.

However, he has not withdrawn from the 2026 US Open as of this writing, and reports are favorable that he will compete. His US Open Men's Outrights at BetUS show him as the second choice behind Jannik Sinner at odds of +150.
