The WNBA regular season begins on May 8, 2026, featuring three games, including Connecticut vs. New York, Washington vs. Toronto, and Golden State vs. Seattle.

Caitlin Clark will receive a substantial raise over her \$78,066 base salary due to the new WNBA Collective Bargaining Agreement and a higher salary cap. In 2026, Clark will be paid \$528,846, including an option in 2027 for \$597,596.

Who is the highest-paid WNBA player?

The Indiana Fever's Kelsey Mitchell is the league's highest-paid player with a salary of approximately \$1.4 million. However, the Las Vegas Aces' superstar, A'ja Wilson, is scheduled for a supermax contract this year of \$1.4 million as well.
