

Latest Announcements

- The World's Best Airline becomes the first carrier globally to install Starlink on Boeing 787-8 aircraft – with three Dreamliners already equipped. Following its pioneering Boeing 777 rollout programme, Qatar Airways also completed the first Airbus A350 Starlink installation in aviation history. Nearly 120 widebody aircraft are now Starlink-equipped, offering faster-than-home Wi-Fi experience on various routes across six continents, including long- and ultra-long-haul. Since the programme rollout in October 2024, Qatar Airways has connected over 11 million passengers with Starlink.
- On 5 January 2026, Qatar Airways marked the launch of three non-stop weekly flights between Hamad International Airport (DOH) in Qatar and Hail International Airport (HAS), its 13th destination in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The new route underscores the airline's strategic focus on expanding its presence across the Kingdom, highlighting the importance of the Saudi market in its global network.
- Qatar Airways unveiled its first-ever digital destination, 'QVerse Island' in Fortnite, one of the world's most popular digital environments. QVerse Island reimagines the capital of Qatar, Doha, by offering travellers a new, immersive way to explore the city while engaging with the airline's brand experience.






