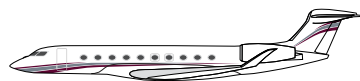

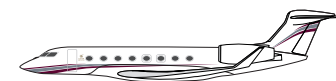

- Qatar Airways Group today announced a post-tax profit of QAR 7.08bn (US\$ 1.94bn) for financial year 2025/26. The results demonstrate a robust performance against a final month impacted by significant geopolitical events, reaffirming its position as one of global aviation's most resilient Groups.

- Qatar Airways has officially unveiled its FIFA special livery aircraft on a Boeing 777 ahead of the FIFA World Cup 2026™, celebrating the airline's longstanding partnership with FIFA. The special livery aircraft will operate across key destinations in Europe, the United States and Asia, engaging fans around the world as excitement continues to build ahead of the FIFA World Cup 2026™.
- The airline is rebuilding its global network to resume service to Alexandria, Abu Dhabi, Cairo, Cape Town, Dar es Salaam, Kigali, Lusaka-Harare, Maputo-Durban, Marrakesh, and Seychelles. Qatar Airways is also increasing global connectivity with its launch to Caracas, Bogotá, and Port Sudan, and return to Helsinki and Tokyo Haneda.

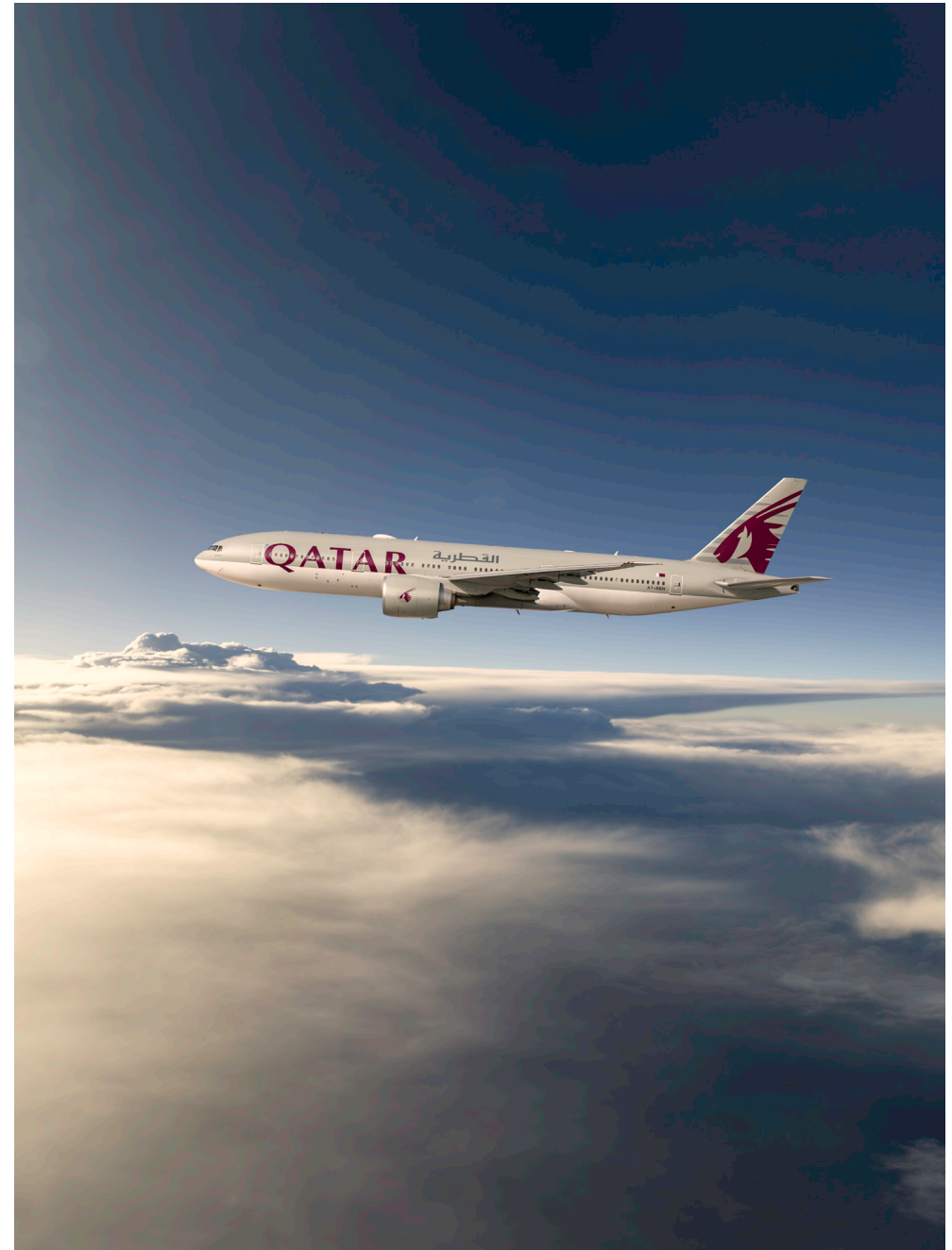

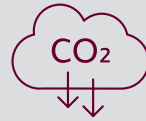
