Combining intuitive design, useful features and top-tier performance, the new Canyon Commuter bikes were made to exceed the expectations of the most discerning city cyclist. Whether you're commuting to work, pedalling to the shops or just popping out for a joy ride, our designers and engineers considered every little detail to create innovative solutions that will make your daily commute a daily delight.





## COMMUTE

Blending agile handling with hardwearing components and award-winning minimalist design, the Commuter has set the standard for urban bikes since its launch in 2016 and it just got even better. With an updated frame design, clever details like the adjustable 20mm cockpit spacer and dynamo-powered lights, the bike finds the ideal balance between clean aesthetics, long-term comfort and practical functionality.

The new Commuter range features three distinct models designed to meet the diverse needs of a wide array of urban riders. From the entry-level Commuter 5 with its stripped-down, high-value setup to the fully-kitted Commuter 7 and its pedal-powered lights, there's a Commuter that's right for everyone.

## REDISCOVER YOUR CITY

We know the practical reasons to commute by bicycle. It's better for your health and for the environment, you save money you would normally spend on gas or train fare, and you never have to sit in traffic. But we rarely talk about the best reason: It makes the mundane magical.

Your drive to work on the main thoroughfare transforms into an exciting exploration of side streets. The descent to your local bar morphs from a push of your car's brake pedal to a two-wheeled downhill rollercoaster. Storefronts you usually speed by reveal themselves as your neighbourhood's hidden gems. It's like seeing the city with new eyes.

Lightweight, beautifully-designed and built to handle daily riding in any conditions, the new Commuter makes pedalling around town the carefree and joyful experience it should be. There's never been a better opportunity to shake up the routine and Rediscover Your City.





## **BUILT TO LAST. MADE TO PERFORM.**

A capable urban bike has to stand up to the daily grind. Rain or shine, on wet roads or dry, you should feel confident getting around on your bike and rest easy knowing that it won't need a tune-up after just a few weeks of regular riding. That's why all Commuter models are made from durable aluminium, feature internally-routed cables and come outfitted with weather-resistant carbon belt drives and internal gear hubs.

Yet it doesn't matter how robust a bike is if it doesn't ride well. Drawing on years of experience designing Grand Tour-winning road bikes, our engineers found the sweet spot between comfort, speed and agility when creating the Commuter. Smaller 650B wheels enhance the bike's handling to make it more responsive for navigating crowded streets while its relaxed geometry makes for comfortable riding no matter how far you want to pedal.

## SMALL DETAILS. BIG DIFFERENCE.

When designing a modern urban bike, small changes have a big impact. The updated Commuter range features a state-of-art tube profile that makes the frame even more striking than before. The new D-shape of the head tube melds seamlessly with the bike's cockpit to create a distinct unified form that is sure to turn heads.

Form follows function. Even the base-level Commuter 5 comes with internally-routed cables for a tidy silhouette and improved weather protection. Commuter 6 and 7 models feature robust rear racks ready-made with the Ortlieb QL3.1 quick lock system. It's a small tweak that makes it easier than ever to transport groceries or gear from point A to point B.





## COMFORT IS KEY

To have a bike be your go-to choice for commuting to work or running errands it has to be comfortable! The riding position of the Commuter has been modified to place riders in a more upright stance and relieve pressure from their hands and shoulders. Not only does this improve general comfort, it also makes it easier for riders to look straight ahead and keep their eyes safely on the traffic in front of them. If you prefer a more aggressive riding position, a special built-in spacer under the cockpit can be removed to lower handlebar height by 20 mm.



## TWO UNIQUE FRAMES

The new Commuter 5, 6 and 7 models are each available in two different frame variants. The step-over frame falls clearly in line with our award-winning design language. Its clear lines, internally-routed cables and semi-integrated cockpit give the bike a clean look and make it stand out from the crowd.

The Commuter WMN mid-step frame shares the same features but utilizes a more angled top tube to lower standover height and make the bike easier to step through. This provides riders of all heights and sizes a commuter bike that they can easily mount and dismount.





## FEATURES

A great urban bike is set apart by its features – all of the little things that empower you to ride when you want, and where you want, without worrying if your bike is going to work or if you're going to be safe. It should come with a carbon belt drive and internal hub gearing for smooth weather-resistant shifting and pedalling, disc brakes for reliable stopping power no matter the conditions and wide tyres for bump absorption and good traction.

Higher end models should be outfitted with fenders to keep you clean and dry, a rack for hauling gear, a kickstand mount for easy parking and pedal-powered lights for riding in the dark. Loaded up with so many accessories, it's a real achievement that the Commuter doesn't compromise on weight, handling or minimalist design.

## BELT DRIVE & INTERNAL GEARING

The list of why carbon belt drives are the best choice for city riding is long. They don't require lube, so you never have to worry about getting grease on your clothes or hands. They reduce noise and friction for smoother, quieter pedalling. They don't stretch or rust for improved performance over a longer lifespan. They make riding through the city in any conditions simple and stress-free, so every Commuter comes equipped with one.

As if a belt drive alone wasn't enough, all Commuters also come kitted with internal gear hubs. Shimano Nexus and Alfine hubs protect your gears from the elements and provide reliably smooth shifting while requiring next to no maintenance. The value-focussed Nexus offers 8 accurate gears of grip shifting while the high-level Alfine delivers 11 seamless shifts at the push of a handlebar mounted lever. Combined with a carbon belt drive and it's harder to find a smoother and more hassle-free setup than this.





## LIGHTS

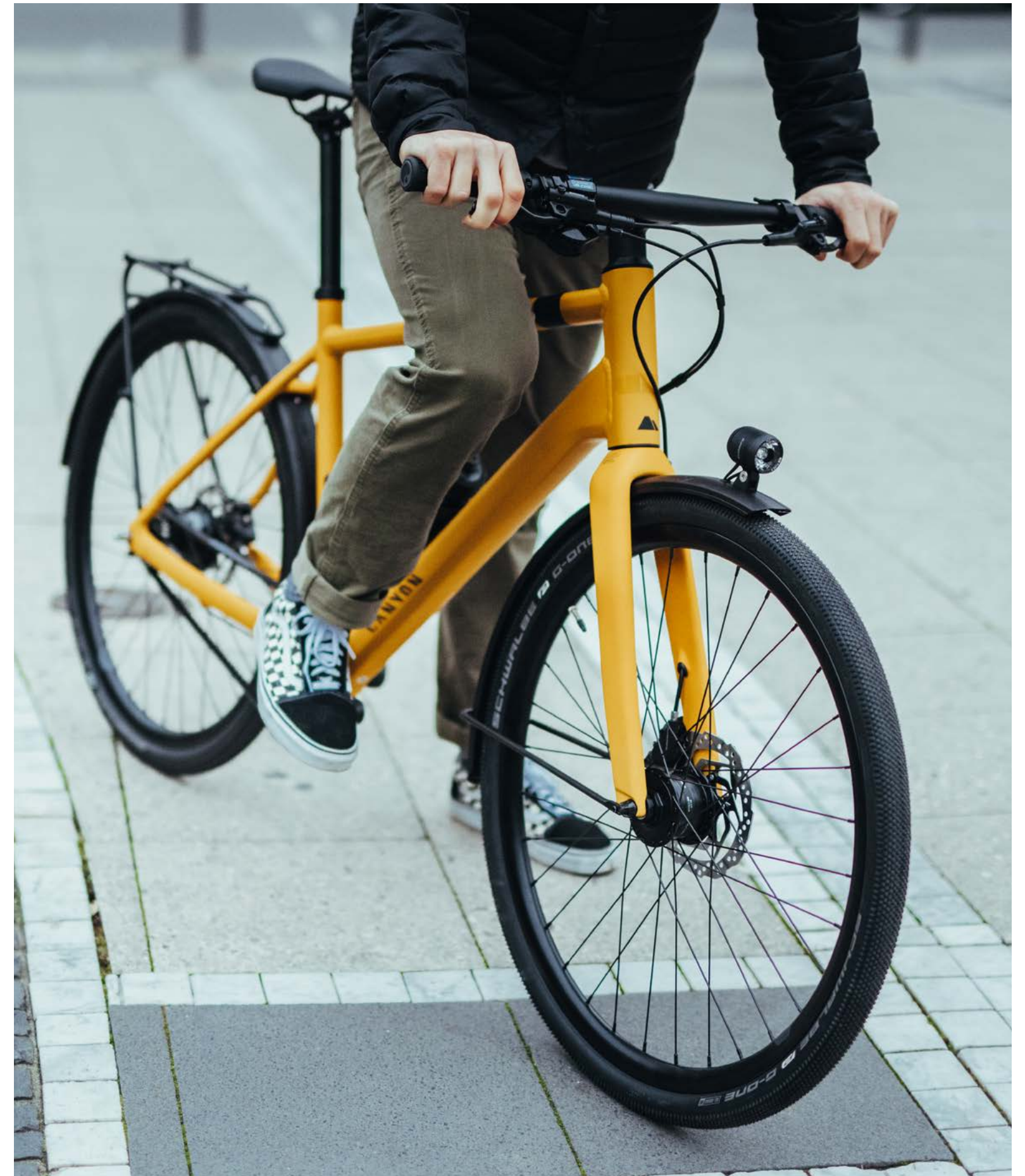
When you're riding in the dark, lights are a must. Not only will a bright front light help you see where you're going, both front and rear lights ensure you're highly visible to traffic and help keep you safe. Lights are a necessity for riding in the city, but it can be a real hassle always making sure they're charged. With the Commuter that's not an issue, as all light-equipped models come with dynamo hub-powered Supernova lights! That means whenever your front wheel starts turning, your lights automatically engage to guarantee you can both see and be seen.

Light system cables are discreetly routed through the frame and allow both the front and rear light to run up to four minutes after you've stopped pedalling. The lights even run when it's bright out to further improve safety. The front light of both the Commuter 6 and 7 comes attached to the front fender for a distinct aesthetic and an improved field of view on the road ahead of you.

## RACKS & FENDERS

Fenders and a rack make daily riding in the city a simpler and more carefree experience. Fenders are great for keeping dirt and water off of your clothes and keeping the bike looking fresh as well. The robust, aluminium Wingee fenders on the Commuter attach seamlessly to the frame and match the bike's minimalist look.

In the back, a sleek and discreet rack attaches to the rear fender to make carrying up to 15 kg of gear or supplies a breeze. The rack even uses the Ortlieb QL3.1 quick lock system so that you can quickly and securely attach any compatible Ortlieb pannier or bag.





## BRAKES

Peddalling through city streets at rush hour, you want to be able to stop on a dime. That's why the full Commuter range comes equipped with powerful Shimano hydraulic disc brakes. Not only do the brakes provide enhanced safety through their excellent stopping power, they also continue to work well even in wet or muddy conditions. Ergonomic brake levers offer precise modulation which allows riders to better control their speed and avoid incident.



## DESIGN

Good design matters. It's not enough to simply outfit a bike with all of the necessary components and accessories. All parts should fit with the form. The Commuter range achieves just that with its high-level integration and minimalist aesthetics, all at an unbeatable price point.

Every model features internally-routed cables and internal gear hubs. Not only does this improve the longevity of the bikes, it removes visual clutter from their pared-down silhouettes. The new semi-integrated cockpit and headtube design of the Commuter 5, 6 and 7 creates a dynamic form that only further enhances the bike's forward-thinking design.



# FAQ

**WHEN DOES THE EMBARGO EXPIRE ON NEW COMMUTER MODELS? WHEN CAN JOURNALISTS PUBLISH STORIES AND PHOTOS FROM THIS PRESS LAUNCH?**

The Commuter press embargo ends on December 22, 2020 at 11:00 CEST when the bikes become available on our website. After that, journalists and media are encouraged to publish their stories and reviews.

**HOW MANY COMMUTER MODELS WILL THERE BE IN THE LINE-UP AND HOW MUCH WILL THEY COST?**

The Commuter will be available in seven different models each at a competitive price point. The Commuter 5 and 5 WMN starts at €999, the Commuter 6 and 6 WMN at €1,299, the Commuter 7 and 7 WMN at €1,599 and the flagship Commuter 8, which has not been updated, at €2,399.

**WHEN WILL THE NEW BIKES BE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC?**

The start of sales for new Commuter models will begin December 22, 2020.

**HOW MANY SIZES ARE ON OFFER?**

All step-over Commuter models will be available in sizes S – XL while mid-step (WMN) Commuter models will be available in sizes XS – M.

**WHY DO WE HAVE TWO DIFFERENT FRAME OPTIONS?**

To give riders of all sizes the same high levels of performance and functionality we created a mid-step version (WMN) of the Commuter. The mid-step frame makes mounting and dismounting the bike easy even when it's loaded down with supplies.

**HOW MUCH WEIGHT CAN I PUT ON THE RACK?**

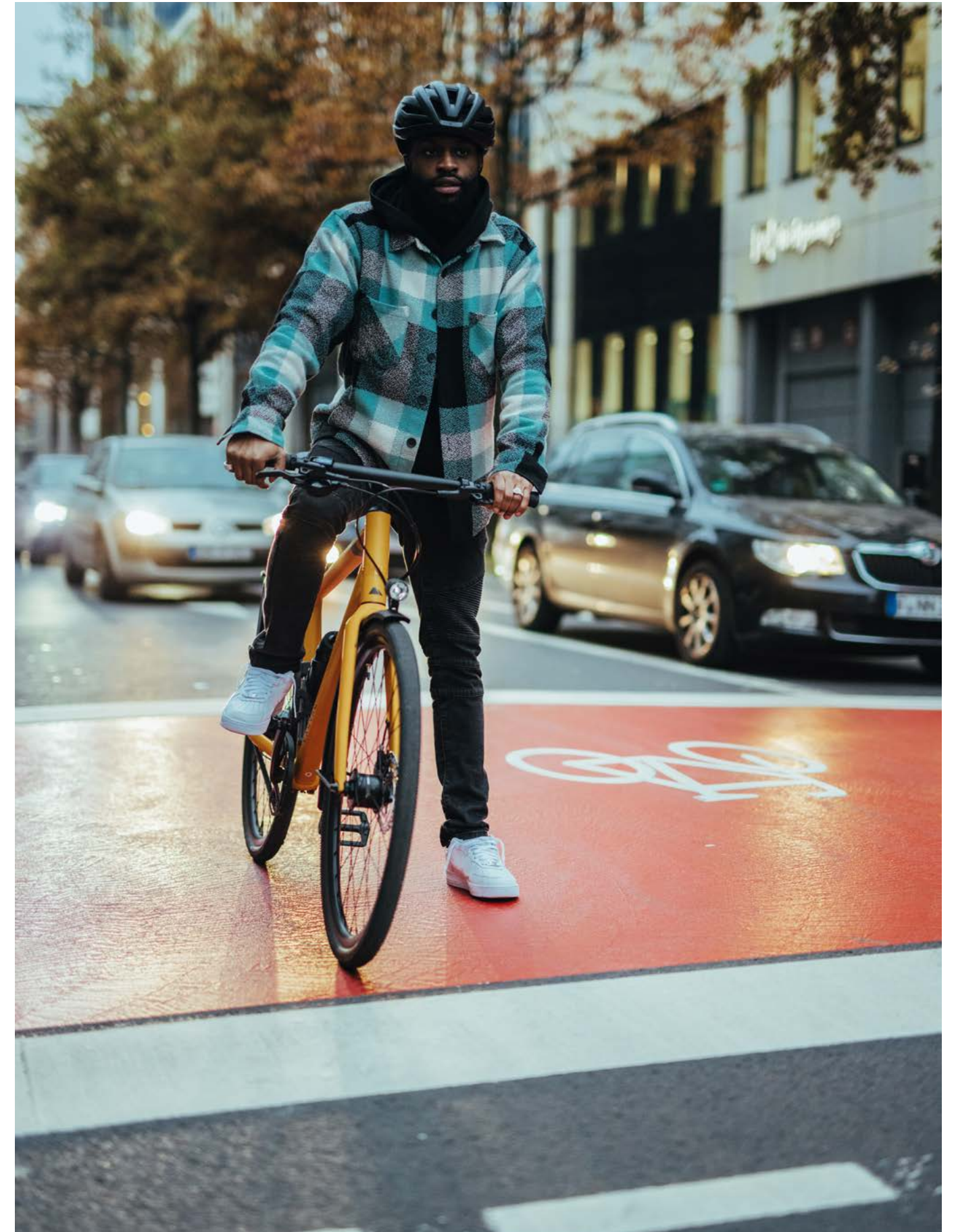
The rear rack is rated to hold up to 15 kg.

**CAN I MOUNT A KICKSTAND TO THE COMMUTER?**

The step-over and mid-step versions of the Commuter 5, 6 and 7 all feature a KSA-40 kickstand mount.

**CAN I ADJUST MY RIDING POSITION?**

The Commuter 5, 6 and 7 models use a 20mm spacer which can be disassembled for a more aggressive riding position.

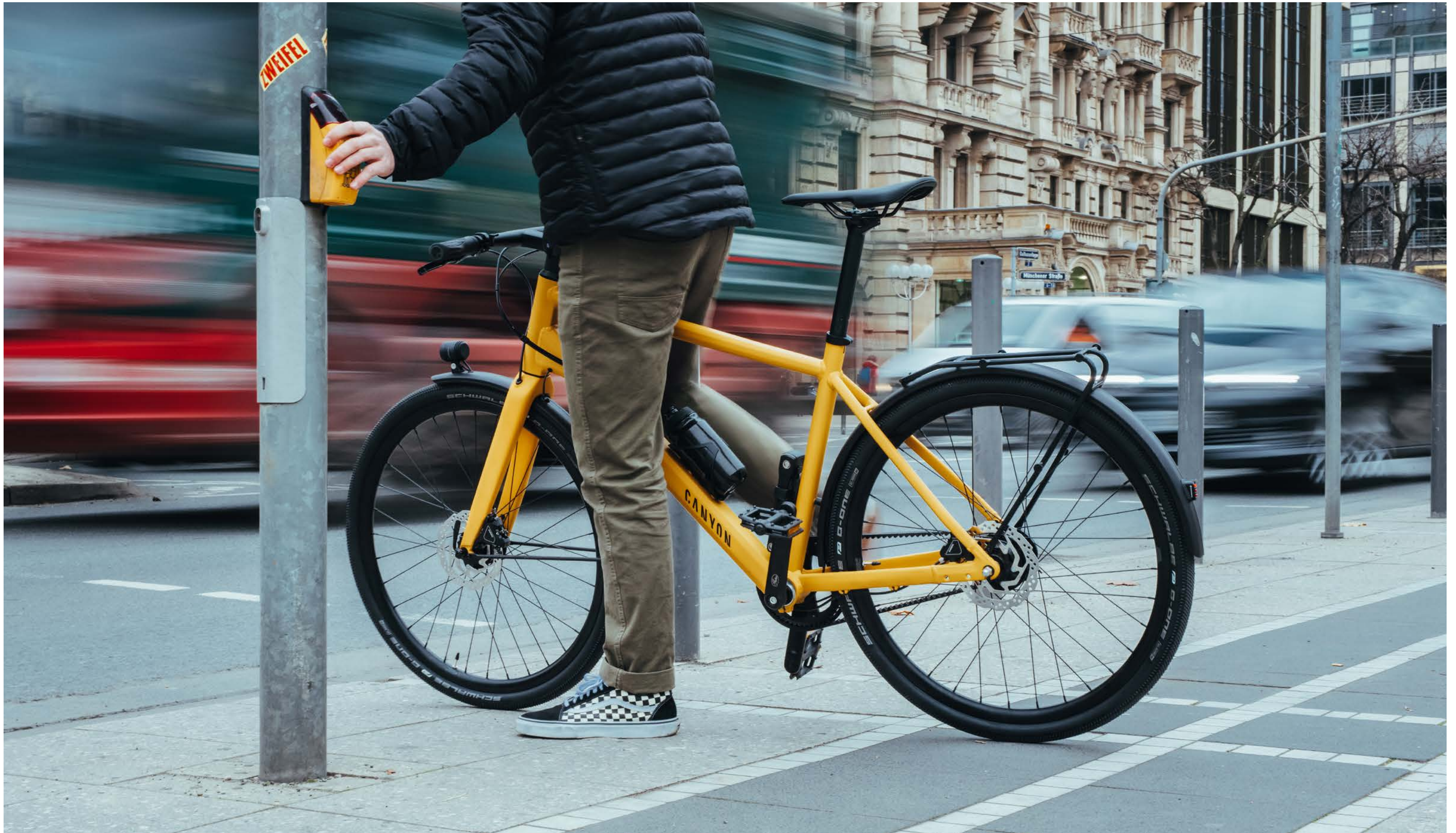
