27, USA

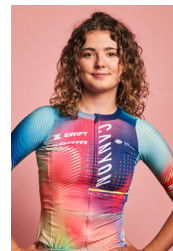
with an enviable palmares of multiple world champion and Olympic medals on the road and track, shown an unquestionable resilience after encountering countless setbacks in her career.

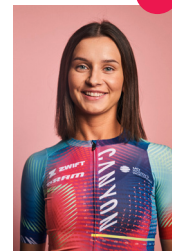
**ALICE TOWERS**
