THE PERFECT WHEEL-TIRE COMBINATION

Wider tyres might be MTB fashion but we wanted Grand Canyon to feel like a running shoe not a heavy hiking boot. 25 mm rims and high performance 2.25in tires save up to 800 grams to put your bike on it's toes for faster acceleration and a fresh, responsive ride feel.

SMOOTHER IS SAFER

Increased 120 mm travel let Grand Canyon tame Alpine lines or keep you and your shopping safe on slippery city cobbles. Even our smallest Grand Canyon Young Hero 24" gets 80 mm of custom tuned smooth safety as standard.



RAISE YOUR GAME - DROP YOUR SEAT

Lower top tube and long dropper seat posts compatibility (fitted as standard on Grand Canyon 7 and 8) let you move with the terrain so you're a pilot not a passenger.

CENTERED & BALANCED POSITION WITHIN THE BIKE

Rider centred geometry on all sizes takes the worry out of wild riding or just wet streets.

45 mm stem and 760 mm bars on XL-XS (700 and 620 mm on Young Hero 27" and 24") add power steering precision.



STOP WORRYING

Hydraulic disc brakes with 180 mm rotors mean totally calm control on the steepest slopes in all weathers even when loaded. Grand Canyon Young Hero 24" gets junior specific disc brakes with 160 mm rotors so the smallest adventurers are totally safe, too.

FRAMED FOR ADVENTURE

While it's happy helping with the shopping or riding to school, Grand Canyon isn't just a lookalike soft roader. It's a bike with its heart truly in the mountains.

That heart is a totally fresh, slimline alloy frame that weighs less than 2 kg in a medium size but is still Category 3 'all mountain' tough. Complete bike weights from 12.5 kg (11.5 kg on our Young Hero 24") amplify that advantage up technical climbs, away from stop lights or just when storing and transporting your bike.

Grand Canyon's new frame isn't just light enough to make "far" closer and "steep" easier either. It's also sculpted to be forgiving and friendly however long your adventure so vibrations won't ruin your vibe. Cleaner internal cable aesthetic makes bag mounting easier while the minimalist look is enhanced with fresh, natural colour options and protection where it matters.

We've already told you about the multiple mounting points, plus dropper post, kickstand, 2.4 in tire and trailer axle compatibility. But Grand Canyon also gets a UDH gear hanger* and threaded BSA bottom bracket for easy spares sourcing and servicing wherever in the world your ride takes you.

Genuinely a bike that will stand out on the high street and stand up to adventures in the high mountains.

Q12 HOW HAS THE GEOMETRY OF THE NEW GRAND CANYON EVOLVED?

The new Grand Canyon has undergone key geometry updates to enhance rider confidence, comfort, and performance for an enjoyable, engaging ride on any terrain. Here are the notable changes:

1. Trail-Optimized Design

- **LOWER TOP TUBE**
Improves standover clearance when stopped so you're not stranded when you straddle the bike. Also allows longer stroke dropper posts for greater freedom of movement on technical trails.
- **STEEPER SEAT TUBE ANGLE (75°)**
Positions the rider more efficiently over the pedals for improved climbing performance and better traction.
- **SLACK HEAD TUBE ANGLE (66°)**
Increases self centring, line holding stability on descents and rowdy terrain.

2. Modernized Geometry for Better Fit

- **SIZE-SPECIFIC ADJUSTMENTS**
 - Youth-friendly geometries for 3XS and 2XS models with reduced reach and optimized cockpit sizes.
 - Adult sizes (S-XL) maintain a balanced reach and stack for a confident, upright position without compromising agility.
- **WHEELBASE IMPROVEMENTS**
A longer wheelbase across all sizes enhances stability at high speeds, in corners and over rough terrain.
- **BALANCED FOR VERSATILITY**
The geometry strikes a fine balance between aggressive trail riding and comfort for bikepacking or commuting, making it a true all-rounder.

Q13 HOW MANY FRAME SIZES ARE THERE FOR THE GRAND CANYON?

We offer the Grand Canyon in seven sizes - 3XS to XL:

- **3XS (Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24" only): 125-145 cm (7-11 years)**
- **2XS (Grand Canyon Young Hero 27,5" only): 145-152 cm (10-14 years)**
- **XS-XL: 152-202 cm**

Q14 WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT SYSTEM WEIGHT LIMIT OF THE NEW GRAND CANYON?

The overall system weight limit is at 120 kg.

Q15 CAN IT TOW A TRAILER?

Yes, the Grand Canyon is approved for use with a trailer. You can use our GP0552-01 trailer axle (10014571) for this. However, please note that the Grand Canyon has a maximum system weight of 120 kg.

Q16 WHAT AXLE STANDARD DOES THE GRAND CANYON USE?

All 29 and 27.5in wheeled Grand Canyon models use the 'Boost' thru-axle standard with 110mm front hub width and 15mm axle and a 148mm hub width 12mm axle rear. The Grand Canyon Young Hero 24" uses a quick-release axle with a 135 mm hub width and a 5 mm diameter.

Q17 HOW MUCH FRONT SUSPENSION TRAVEL DOES THE GRAND CANYON OFFER?

All forks we spec'ed for our Grand Canyon bike offer 120 mm of travel, with the exception of 3XS-sized Grand Canyons, which feature 80 mm of front suspension travel.

Q18 WHAT ABOUT THE WHEEL SIZE?

We offer the Grand Canyon in sizes ranging from 24" to 29".

- **3XS • 24"**
- **2XS-XS • 27.5"**
- **S-XL • 29"**

Q19 WHAT STRENGTH CATEGORY IS THE GRAND CANYON TESTED TO?

The overall system weight limit is at 120 kg.

Q20 CAN IT TOW A TRAILER?

The Grand Canyon is strength tested to Category 3. The same all mountain rating as our all time full-suspension hero, the Neuron.

Q21 ARE THE FRAME PROTECTORS GLUED OR SCREWED TO THE NEW GRAND CANYON?

We used bonded rather than bolted frame protectors to eliminate the potential for rattling and save weight.

Q22 WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM REAR TIRE CLEARANCE ON THE NEW GRAND CANYON?

The Grand Canyon frame supports tire widths up to 2.40".

Q23 WHAT ABOUT THE CABLE ROUTING? HOW ARE THE CABLES ROUTED THROUGH THE FRAME?

Cables are routed internally through the down tube entering just behind the head tube and exiting just ahead of the bottom bracket

Q24 WHAT ABOUT A RACK?

Yes, our own rack GP0613-01 can be mounted on all Grand Canyon models apart from the smallest (Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24").

Q25 AND A KICKSTAND?

Yes, you can mount a kickstand with a KSA40 interface on all Grand Canyons, aside from the Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24".

Q26 WHAT ELSE CAN I MOUNT TO THE GRAND CANYON?

- Two bolt mount on top of the top tube lets you securely attach the Canyon Load top tube bag (10005997) strap free.
- Two bolt mount under the top tube, lets you securely mount either the Canyon Load frame bag (10008082) or the Canyon Fix 6in1 tool (10012529 +10011313).
- On the down tube, you can mount a bottle cage as usual on the top, and you also have the option to mount another bottle cage underneath the down tube.
- Lastly, there's the option to mount a bottle cage on the seat tube, except on the Grand Canyon Young Hero 24", where there isn't enough space.

Q27 CAN I ADD ANOTHER BOTTLE?

Yes, we equipped the Grand Canyon with a bottle cage mount at the top and bottom of the downtube and seattube. So you have the option to carry 3 bottles up to 750 ml, except on Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24" which only has room for two 750ml bottles

ABOUT THE TECH DETAILS

Q28 CAN I MOUNT ACCESSORIES ON THE STEM?

Yes, the stem on the Grand Canyon has the Canyon Gear interface, which allows you to mount our Garmin mount and the Canyon Flash front light or an action camera.

Q29 DO I NEED TO BUY ANY SEPARATE ADAPTERS TO MOUNT LIGHTS OR COMPUTERS ON THE STEM?

The Canyon Gear Interface is designed to be used with the Canyon Garmin mount or direct with GoPro style tab mounts.

Q30 WHICH DERAILLEUR HANGER IS USED?

The Grand Canyon frame, except for the Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24", uses the UDH - Universal Derailleur Hanger (10006305). On the Grand Canyon Young Hero AL 24", we use the derailleur hanger No 12 (148708).

Q31 WHAT BOTTOM BRACKET STANDARD IS USED?

The Grand Canyon frame comes with a screw in 73 mm BSA bottom bracket.

Q32 WHAT CHAIN RING SIZE CAN BE MOUNTED?

The following chainring sizes can be mounted on the Grand Canyon in size 2XS to XL.

- Min. 28T
- Max. 34T

Q33 WHAT ABOUT THE SEATPOST DIAMETER?

All Grand Canyon's use a 31.6 mm diameter seat post.

Q34 ARE ALL GRAND CANYON MODELS COMPATIBLE WITH DROPPER POSTS?

Yes, you can install a dropper post later on all models as follows:

3XS = 100mm Travel • 250mm Insertion Depth Max.
2XS = 100mm Travel • 325mm Insertion Depth Max.
XS = 125mm Travel • 320mm Insertion Depth Max.
S = 150mm Travel • 325mm Insertion Depth Max.
M = 170mm Travel • 330mm Insertion Depth Max.
L = 170mm Travel • 330mm Insertion Depth Max.
XL = 170mm Travel • 330mm Insertion Depth Max.
