

WHAT TO SEE FROM CANYON AT EUROBIKE 2026

State-of-the-art product designs, revolutionary cycling safety concepts, cutting-edge performance bikes - Canyon's booth (hall 11.0, stand B50) is one not to miss.



For release at 16:00 CEST, Monday 22nd June 2026 – Making its highly anticipated return to Eurobike this week, Canyon Bicycles is set to steal the spotlight in Frankfurt with a ground-breaking portfolio of bikes and accessory concepts, designed to set a direction for the future of cycling innovation.

- Canyon Predict: a breakthrough intelligent safety system architecture for road bikes
- Stingr Smart: a smart helmet to complement Canyon's road bike safety system
- Lux Era: an ambitious vision for cross country (XC)
- Roadlite:ON V2X: a further iteration of Canyon's industry-leading, potentially life-saving V2X (vehicle-to-everything) urban bike concept.

Together, these innovations – making their **world premiere at Eurobike** - reinforce Canyon's long-term commitment to performance, safety and digital integration. Moreover, Canyon will explain how these cutting-

edge innovations can soon become a commercial reality.

"At Eurobike 2026, we are presenting a vision where performance, safety, and intelligence are no longer separate categories or restricted to a particular type of riding," said Canyon's Chief Technology Officer Chad Manuell. "Our goal is to redefine what riders expect from a modern bicycle – whether that's in making connected cycling more intuitive, safer, and future-proof, or in pushing the boundaries in terms of racing performance – and help riders focus on the essentials, on the purity of the ride. We look forward to discussing these innovations and hearing the feedback from the cycling community."

- [Endurace CF SLX](#) - fresh out this April, an aero bike with all-day fit, ready for all-road action
- [Roadlite:ON](#) - just released! An singlespeed e-bike built for the city.
- [Inflite CFR](#) - the frame platform that Mathieu van der Poel took to eight world championship titles.
- Exceed drop bar - as ridden at Atlas Mountain Race.
- [Lux World Cup CFR](#) - Luca Schwarzbauer's Cape Epic stage winning bike.

Several unreleased bikes will also be on display from Canyon too, including:

- the gravel race bike of [Canyon x DT Swiss All Terrain Racing's Juri Hollmann](#)
- Canyon's next-generation Trail E-MTB equipped with an Avinox M2S motor
- and a Canyon long travel E-MTB prototype equipped with an Avinox MG concept motor.
