A neo-renaissance palace in the centre of Prague where historic glamour meets modern comforts

NH Collection Prague Carlo IV is located in the captivating neo-renaissance palace nestled in the heart of Prague. Once home to the First Czech Land Mortgage Bank, this historic gem now embodies the perfect blend of old-world charm and contemporary elegance.

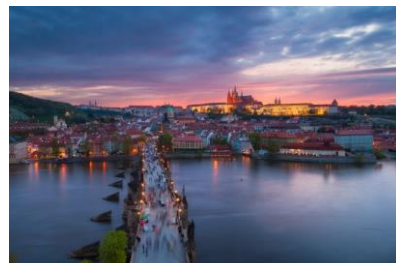
The hotel's grand lobby is the most iconic room in the building; in the colossal hall, with its four dominant black alabaster ionic pillars, soft light emphasises the 19th century's decoration. It is a space that combines a distinctive ambience with a flexible, all-day-dining service.

This exquisite property offers 152 elegant and individually designed rooms and suites. Boasting a sought-after wellness and spa with a heated swimming pool, state-of-the-art meeting facilities with over 1000m², and a recent design update in 2022, NH Collection Prague Carlo IV promises an unforgettable experience for both leisure and business travellers alike.

As the group's third property in Prague and fourth in the Czech Republic, it stands as a testament to elegance and sophistication in one of Europe's most enchanting cities.

Location

Conveniently located out of the main tourist hub, yet close enough to reach all significant sights by an easy walk



NH Collection Prague Carlo IV is located on Senovážné náměstí in the centre of Prague, on the border of the Old and New City of Prague. The hotel is just ten minutes' walk from Old Town Square, the beating heart of Prague. The elegant hotel perfectly complements the smart and modern Wenceslas Square as well as the historic Old Town.

Narrow streets that meander through towers and pinnacles help create the unique atmosphere of this legendary city. NH Collection Prague Carlo IV is five minutes away from the Prague State Opera and within easy reach of Prague's major tourist attractions, including Municipal House, Powder Tower, and Old Town Square. Equally close to the hotel are the iconic Charles Bridge and the Jewish Quarter with the oldest European Jewish Cemetery and Synagogue. Prague Castle, founded in 880 and the largest castle complex in the world, is reachable in around 40 minutes on foot or accessible by public transport from the hotel.

Design

Where history meets contemporary elegance



NH Collection Prague Carlo IV was originally opened as the "First Czech Land Mortgage Bank" built in the late 1890s by famous Viennese architect Achille Wolf. The hotel's neo-renaissance façade recalls the architecture of the National Theatre and the National Museum. It is decorated with metal reliefs that represent the evolution of coinage in the Czech Kingdom. With the arrival of the communist power, it became the Prague Post Office Headquarters which marked the darkest chapter in the history of this palace. The Post Office was in fact the 'black cabinet': the seat of postal censorship.

The task of modifying this historical palace into a luxury hotel was given to Italian architects Maurizio Papiri and Adam D. Tihany. Meanwhile, the Czech architectural studio DAM extended the property with an entirely new wing. The renovation was completed in 2003. The building is listed as national heritage property.

Throughout the hotel, guests are enveloped in an atmosphere of timeless elegance, where 19th-century décor harmoniously coexists with modern amenities and comforts. 152 elegant rooms are equally distributed in the modern and historic wing. From the high-ceilinged rooms adorned with original frescoes to the sleek, contemporary furnishings of the modern wing, NH Collection Prague Carlo IV offers a captivating journey through Prague's rich architectural heritage. The Presidential and Carlo IV Suites house original frescoes which have been brought back to their former splendour by skilled restorers. The walls of the rooms and suites are decorated original art. En-suite bathrooms are classical in style and showcase an abundance of marble detailing.

The grand lobby is the former terminal hall of the bank that, under the careful supervision of conservationists, has been restored and brought back to its original splendour while still bearing the signs of its history. The former bank's main hall is decorated with coats of arms which represent the cities in which it opened its branches. The lobby's charm has captivated global film productions and the lobby was featured in such Hollywood movies as Bourne's Identity or Spiderman: Far from Home among others.

Restaurant & bars

Gastronomy with local flavours and fresh seasonal ingredients



Phenomenal, healthy and creative gastronomy is one of the NH Collection brand's hallmarks. Combined with a food offering based on ingredients and dishes inspired by the local cuisine, guests can relish an incomparable culinary experience, while discovering their destination of choice through their palates, without having to leave the hotel. The multifunctional space aptly named 1890 Restaurant & Bar, after the year in which the neo-renaissance palace opened, is located just behind the lobby hall. It copies the lobby's full length and affords ample space for guests with different seating options and intimate corners separated by plush velvet curtains that can be open or closed depending on the time of the day. This is where breakfast is served in the morning while in the evening it is a stage for the right culinary experience including the best of local and internationally- inspired cuisine while covering special dietary or cultural needs when required.

The 1890 Bar is situated into the magnificent neo-renaissance hotel lobby and it dazzles guests by the refined architecture. The atmosphere of this sophisticated bar invites guests in to enjoy an aperitif or to round-off the evening in peaceful, chic surroundings. This bar is also one of the most elegant places to meet in Prague, as it is an ideal place for a meeting, in the evening often with a live music production.

The Vault bar provides a highly intimate atmosphere thanks to the origin of its location. This is the former bank's treasury – one of the oldest one in Central Europe – which dates back to 1895. Staying true to the building's heritage as a bank, the treasury door is secured by the original locking system provided by Viennese company Wertheim (still in operation) and is fully functional, even today. Formerly used as a safe for money and shares, today it hosts an exhibition of the bank's past. The Vault can be booked for private events and guests can enjoy drinks here in the evening.

Nestled within the subterranean vault, [Carlo IV Wellness & Spa](#) offers a sanctuary of tranquility and rejuvenation.
