

Tivoli Hotels & Resorts to Launch in Portugal's Porto Region with Tivoli Kopke Porto Gaia Hotel

Minor Hotels announces the continued expansion of Tivoli Hotels & Resorts in Portugal, the brand's home country, with the upcoming launch of Tivoli Kopke Porto Gaia Hotel. Located on the south bank of the Douro River, in the city of Gaia, the hotel is scheduled to open early in 2025 and boasts a privileged panoramic view over Porto.

Currently under development, the new Tivoli Kopke will set a new standard for luxury hospitality in the northern region of Portugal, combining Tivoli's heritage of timeless travel with the unique history and legacy of Kopke, the oldest Port Wine House in the world, established in 1638.

Perfect for business and leisure travellers alike, the hotel will feature 150 guest rooms including 10 suites, two restaurants, three bars, two swimming pools, a Tivoli Shape fitness centre, fully equipped events facilities with six meeting rooms, and 9,000 sqm of exterior gardens to welcome special gatherings and celebrations. The property will also be home to a unique Tivoli Spa, where bespoke therapies will be aligned with the destination and inspired by its natural elements.

Tivoli Kopke Porto Gaia Hotel is located on the hillside of Gaia in an ancient Port Wine cellar that will be part of the hotel experience. With views over Porto city and its traditional Cais da Ribeira and the emblematic Luís I Bridge, the hotel is walking distance from main local attractions with direct access to the lively and beautiful Gaia river front area, with its restaurants, bars and shops. The city of Porto is just a few minutes' walk, Devesas train station is close by, and Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport is a 30-minute drive.

The current hotel construction is being carefully curated to pay tribute to the history of Kopke, a brand that is older than Douro's demarcated region and a leader in the production of tawny and white port. The unique Kopke Port Wine cellar adjoining the hotel will be one of the most exclusive attractions, allowing guests to enjoy an immersive experience in the world of the most recognised fortified wine – port.

Unique gastronomic experiences at the hotel will include a fine-dining restaurant lead by a renowned chef who will bring a new soon-to-be-revealed concept. For a more relaxed experience there will be an all-day-dining restaurant along with a wine bar and a rooftop bar overlooking the Douro River with its typical Rabelo boats, and Porto city.

Established in 1638, before the demarcation of the Douro Wine Region in 1756, [Kopke](#) is the oldest Port Wine House in the world. Founded by Nicolau Kopke, the company evolved from a diverse business to become a renowned producer of Port wine. The purchase of Quinta de S. Luiz in 1922 consolidated its role as an important Port wine producer.

Kopke is one of the main brands of the Sogevinus group, accounting for over 75% of sales in foreign markets, namely the Netherlands, USA, South Korea, Denmark and the United Kingdom.

With its extensive library of old wines, which includes remarkably rare White and Tawny ports, this has long established Kopke's reputation as the maker of some of the very best Port wines.
