During this mesmerising journey along the River Main, guests can admire Frankfurt's iconic landmarks while enjoying an upbeat playlist. The Waterbike Tour provides a scenic adventure that offers panoramic views from a different perspective, blending the city's historical charm with its vibrant contemporary atmosphere. The Waterbike Tour starts from EUR 69 (approx. USD 74) per person.

In the evenings, mixology maestros can head to the hotel bar to learn the art of smoked cocktails. Created in collaboration with events specialists, [Fullu Events & More](#), this innovative workshop invites guests to delve into the art of mixology and craft their own concoctions infused with smoky flavours. The session is set to a carefully curated soundtrack that traces the evolution of electronic music, enhancing the sensory experience and providing a dynamic backdrop to the evening. The Cocktail Workshop starts from EUR 99 (approx. USD 106) per person.
