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## Location

Anantara Riverside Bangkok Resort is located along the scenic banks of the Chao Phraya River in Bangkok's Thonburi district, offering a peaceful and picturesque setting while remaining close to the city's key attractions. Amidst 11 acres of verdant landscaped gardens, the urban resort provides a complimentary shuttle boat service to the nearby Saphan Taksin BTS Skytrain station and ICONSIAM Mall, allowing guests quick access to the broader Bangkok city area. The BTS is ideal for getting to areas like Silom, Siam, and Sukhumvit. For those who prefer not to stray too far, adjoining the hotel is Riverside Plaza, which offers a variety of restaurants, bars and shops.

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## Getting Here

Suvarnabhumi International Airport (BKK) and Don Muang International Airport (DMK) are both a 45-minute drive from the hotel. In addition to the hotel's Wi-Fi capable limousines, Anantara's fast track greeting service ensures a seamless experience.

It also gives guests the chance to blend wellness with business or leisure in an urban environment.
3. **Anantara Riverside Bangkok Resort is one of the few remaining low-rise style hotels on the river.** Offering a distinctive, intimate atmosphere that contrasts with the high-rise hotels and modern skyscrapers increasingly populating Bangkok's skyline. Its low-rise, resort-style design allows for expansive, beautifully landscaped grounds with lush gardens, winding pathways, and unobstructed views of the river, enhancing the sense of seclusion and serenity for guests.

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## Top 5 Tips For An Unforgettable Stay

1. **Download the Anantara app.** This invites guests to tailor their stay in advance or from the comfort of their room, including seamlessly making reservations, arranging a last-minute laundry pick-up or even order a turndown at the click of a button.

2. **Make the most of the shuttle boat, it's a really fun way to see Bangkok.** The complimentary shuttle boat is scheduled to welcome guests aboard at either the resort, BTS station - Saphan Taksin or ICONSIAM Mall daily starting from 8.00 am - 11.15 pm.
3. **Feed the giant catfish.** Two feeding stations are located on the Bang Nam Chon Canal, which bisects the resort. The canal is home to hundreds of giant catfish who jostle to enjoy the pellets. In Thai culture, feeding fish, especially at temples or riversides, is considered an auspicious activity that brings good fortune. This act, known as "tamboon" (ทำบุญ) or "making merit," is seen as a way to show compassion and kindness towards other living beings, helping to accumulate positive karma. Many Thais believe that feeding fish, particularly river fish such as catfish, brings luck, prosperity, and peace of mind.
4. **Take a moment to listen to the Gamelatron in the main lobby.** The resort's lobby is home to Bangkok's first and only Gamelatron, a groundbreaking sonic-kinetic gamelan installation by artist Aaron Taylor Kuffner. This innovative artwork combines traditional Indonesian gamelan instruments with modern technology. Kuffner's Gamelatron features handcrafted bronze instruments fitted with robotic mallets that are digitally controlled to create mesmerising, automated performances. The piece, named *Gamelatron Pohon Electrum 2015*, is carefully installed in the resort's lobby, where it greets visitors with a unique blend of traditional Southeast Asian sounds and contemporary artistry.
5. **Take in the views from the river on an antique 100-year-old rice barge.** The Manohra Dinner Cruise departs the resort daily at 5:00pm, 7:00pm and 8:30pm and is the perfect way to experience the majestic Chao Phraya River, royal palaces, and glittering temples, all with a glass of bubbles in hand.

### What's In A Name?

- Derived from the Sanskrit word meaning “without end”, the word “Anantara” embraces the excitement of discovery and the vibrant energy of new horizons.
  - The name "Bangkok" comes from the Thai words "Bang" and "Ko(k)." Originally, "Bang" referred to a village or settlement along a river or waterway, and "Ko(k)" could mean "island" or "wild plum" tree. Thus, Bangkok likely referred to a "village on the river with wild plum trees." In its early days, Bangkok was a small trading post on the banks of the Chao Phraya River. However, the full ceremonial name of Bangkok is much longer and is actually recorded in the Guinness World Records as the longest place name in the world. This ceremonial name is: "*Krung Thep Maha Nakhon Amon Rattanakosin Mahinthara Ayuthaya Mahadilok Phop Noppharat Ratchathani Burirom Udomratchaniwet Mahasathan Amon Piman Awatan Sathit Sakkathattiya Witsanukam Prasit*," which translates roughly to "City of Angels, Great City of Immortals, Magnificent City of the Nine Gems, Seat of the King, City of Royal Palaces, Home of the Gods Incarnate, Erected by Vishvakarman at Indra's Behest." Locally, Thai people refer to Bangkok as Krung Thep Maha Nakhon or simply Krung Thep, meaning the "City of Angels."
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## Architecture and Design

Anantara Riverside occupies three connecting colonial-style buildings set amidst a lush tropical garden setting and bisected by Bang Nam Chon Canal. The traditional Thai mural art featured on the wall of the main lobby depicts the arrival of the early settlers from China, Europe and India, at the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Their stilted communities can still be found along the banks of the river to this day.

With rooms featuring hardwood floors and panelling, as well as teak furniture, every detail nods to the resort’s Thai heritage. Ancient writing characters on floor-to-ceiling mirrors also provide a cultural, yet mysterious, touch, and traditional Thai fabrics and authentic textiles bring warmth, opulence and cultural significance to each room.

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## Sustainability Credentials

1. **Oceans For All.** As part of Anantara Riverside’s ongoing sustainability efforts, and in an attempt to protect the planet for future generations the resort has partnered with Oceans For All, a

foundation which raises awareness for marine conservation. Through this collaboration the resort's pier serves as a base for two daily 'clean-up vessels', facilitating the responsible removal and disposal of river waste that chokes the capital's iconic waterway.

2. **Organic waste.** The resort's in-house mulch machine shreds organic waste from gardens and creates its own compost, which is used as fertiliser.
3. **Solar panels.** There are solar panels installed on the roof of the resort, which generate 35% of the hotels' electricity needs over the course of the year.
4. **Landfill waste.** The kitchen team work with local farmers to turn resort food waste into pig feed, resulting in less landfill and supports the local community.
5. **Dollars for Deeds:** Anantara's Dollars for Deeds programme gives guests the option to donate one dollar (THB 30) per night of their stay, with Anantara matching each guest's contribution. The funds raised are donated to three worthwhile foundations: the Golden Triangle Asian Elephant Foundation (GTAEF) in Chiang Rai, the Mai Khao Turtle Foundation in Phuket and the Princess Sirindhorn Craniofacial Centre at Chulalongkorn Hospital in Bangkok.

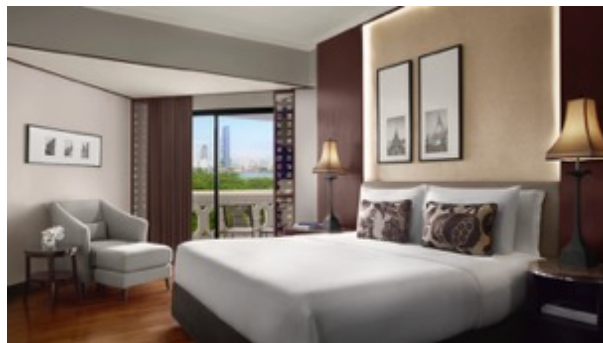

Located near the Grand Palace and covering over 80,000 square meters, the main attraction at Wat Pho is the massive reclining Buddha statue, which measures 46 meters (151 feet) long and 15 meters (49 feet) high. The statue represents Buddha entering Nirvana, symbolizing the end of his reincarnations. The statue is covered in gold leaf, and its feet are inlaid with intricate mother-of-pearl patterns that depict 108 auspicious symbols of Buddha, including flowers, dancers, and mythical creatures.

**Wat Arun**

Wat Arun, also known as the Temple of Dawn, is arguably Bangkok's most iconic and picturesque temple, located on the west bank of the Chao Phraya River. Wat Arun is named after Aruna, the Hindu god of dawn. The temple's design is meant to symbolise Mount Meru, the centre of the universe in Buddhist cosmology, with the prang representing this sacred mountain.
