Anantara Enters Top 5 Hotel Brands in Travel + Leisure World's Best Awards 2026

Four Minor Hotels properties also named among the World's Top 100 Hotels

Hotel Brands in the World, rising to No. 5 from No. 8 last year, as the brand continues to strengthen its position in experiential luxury hospitality.

Minor Hotels' global standing was further strengthened by the inclusion of four properties in the **100 Best Hotels in the World**, up from three last year.

Two elevated safari lodges in Tanzania led Minor Hotels' performance in the Top 100 rankings. The refined country-house retreat Elewana The Manor at Ngorongoro placed at No. 14, while luxury tented camp Elewana Serengeti Migration Camp came in at No. 21, both offering immersive wildlife encounters and dramatic landscapes.

In Minor Hotels' home base of Thailand, Anantara Golden Triangle Elephant Camp & Resort, renowned for its award-winning ethical elephant experiences, landed at No. 37, while Anantara

Layan Phuket Resort, a tranquil beachfront wellness retreat on Phuket's northwest coast, secured the No. 81 spot.

In Europe, Anantara Grand Hotel Krasnapolsky Amsterdam ranked No. 5 Best Hotel in Amsterdam.
