

## Media Kit - NH Collection Palacio de Burgos



### ***The hotel***

The [NH Collection Palacio de Burgos](#) is located in a UNESCO-listed Gothic building erected in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries. Construction of its showpiece, a one-of-a-kind stone cloister, began in the sixteenth century under the leadership of the architect, Juan de Vallejo. The late-Gothic building that is home to the NH Collection Palacio de Burgos has had several uses over the last 500 years, including as a convent, military hospital, academy for army engineers and a Jesuit school, before its current life as a hotel.

It boasts a privileged location in the heart of the city centre, beside the Arlanzón River and just a short walk from one of some of Burgos' main locations, including the cathedral, main square, castle and the Las Huelgas Monastery. It is also very close to the city's convention centre and Museum of Human Evolution, among other attractions, as well as its shopping and restaurant hub.

### ***Services and facilities***

The hotel's 110 spacious and elegant rooms are a clear exponent of the building's history. They are decorated in a classic yet contemporary style, in earthy shades, with dark-wood furniture and wooden floors. Some enjoy spectacular views of Burgos' impressive cathedral and river.

The hotel facilities include a gym, for guests who want to continue to work out throughout their stay in the city, and a sauna, for winding down after a busy day of tourism. The hotel offers its guests parking facilities and charging points for electric vehicles.

### ***Food and drink***

The Palacio de la Merced restaurant is run by chef Agustí Gebelli. It is noted for its seasonal dishes based on traditional cuisine with a very modern touch, as the chef places great importance on technique in striking a balance between the old and the new. The restaurant, rated as one of the city's finest by the prestigious Repsol guide, serves traditional regional fare, such as oxtail and artichokes, with a light cosmopolitan touch and top quality local ingredients.

For an even more memorable stay, the hotel has designed a unique gastronomic offering which starts off with a lavish breakfast buffet, made up of ultra-fresh products inspired by local flavours, breads, pastries, gourmet bites, fruit and yoghurt, along with freshly-made fruit juices, tea and coffee.

The NH Collection Palacio de Burgos also has an elegant lobby bar for a quiet drink or light snack. In addition to its extensive wine and spirits menu, it serves a range of *tapas*, salads and soups.

### ***Meetings and events***

Thanks to its wide variety of facilities and services, the NH Collection Palacio de Burgos is an ideal destination for business and leisure travellers. If you are travelling to the city for professional purposes and want to organise a meeting, it has several suitable function rooms.
