### *Hotel*

**NH Collection Genova Marina** is a refined four-star hotel that blends welcoming design with understated elegance, featuring marine-inspired tones and pastel shades selected to reflect the stunning panorama of Genoa's Porto Antico, redesigned by architect **Renzo Piano**. The building, spread across four floors with slate roofs, washed plaster and red hues typical of Ligurian architecture, appears to float on the water, resting on special stilts that extend over a hundred meters.

Conveniently located near the Aquarium, Museo del Mare, Ponte dei Mille cruise terminal, and overlooking the picturesque Gulf of Genoa, the property is also within walking distance of the city's shopping district and major UNESCO World Heritage Sites such as Palazzo Ducale.

NH Collection Genova Marina maintains a close connection with the city's maritime history. One example is the presence of a traditional "bitta" - a robust mooring post that resists the forces of the sea - displayed in the hotel's hall, lobby, and even visible beneath the glass floor, a meaningful tribute to the city heritage and its historic bond with Porto Antico.

### *Services and facilities*



The hotel offers 140 spacious and comfortable rooms, all inspired by nautical style and atmosphere. Bed headboards feature calming blue and azure tones that recall the colors of the port, while soft pastel hues - like blush pink and sand beige - evoke Ligurian sunsets and the gentle sands of the Riviera. Decorative details such as modern prints depicting sails and sailors, along with brass lamps and fine woodwork, serve as design thread throughout the interiors, enhancing both the common areas and the refined setting of “Il Gozzo” restaurant.

Many rooms overlook the sea or feature charming private terraces that give the hotel the silhouette of an elegant cruise ship. At the stern, guests find the main entrance, while “Il Gozzo” restaurant, located at the bow, offers an exclusive experience with panoramic views of the Lanterna, the iconic lighthouse that has guided sailors since 1543. A small footbridge connects the hotel’s historic side to a newly developed wing, built on stilts during Renzo Piano’s renovation of Porto Antico. From select rooms and from the restaurant itself, guests can also view the dolphin tank of the Aquarium, offering a rare and up-close look at these magnificent marine creatures.

### *Gastronomy*

“Il Gozzo” restaurant, with its two stunning terraces overlooking the sea, invites guests to savour traditional Mediterranean and Ligurian cuisine in a truly unique atmosphere. Each morning begins with a generous buffet breakfast, designed to start the day on the right note.

At the heart of the restaurant lies an elegant bar, the perfect spot to unwind with a glass of wine or enjoy a selection of delightful snacks in a relaxed setting.





### ***Meeting & events***

The hotel features seven meeting rooms filled with natural light and equipped with the latest technology. The main hall can host up to 180 guests, and the hotel's highly qualified staff is on hand to assist in planning every type of event, from weddings and gala dinners to cooking classes and art exhibitions.
