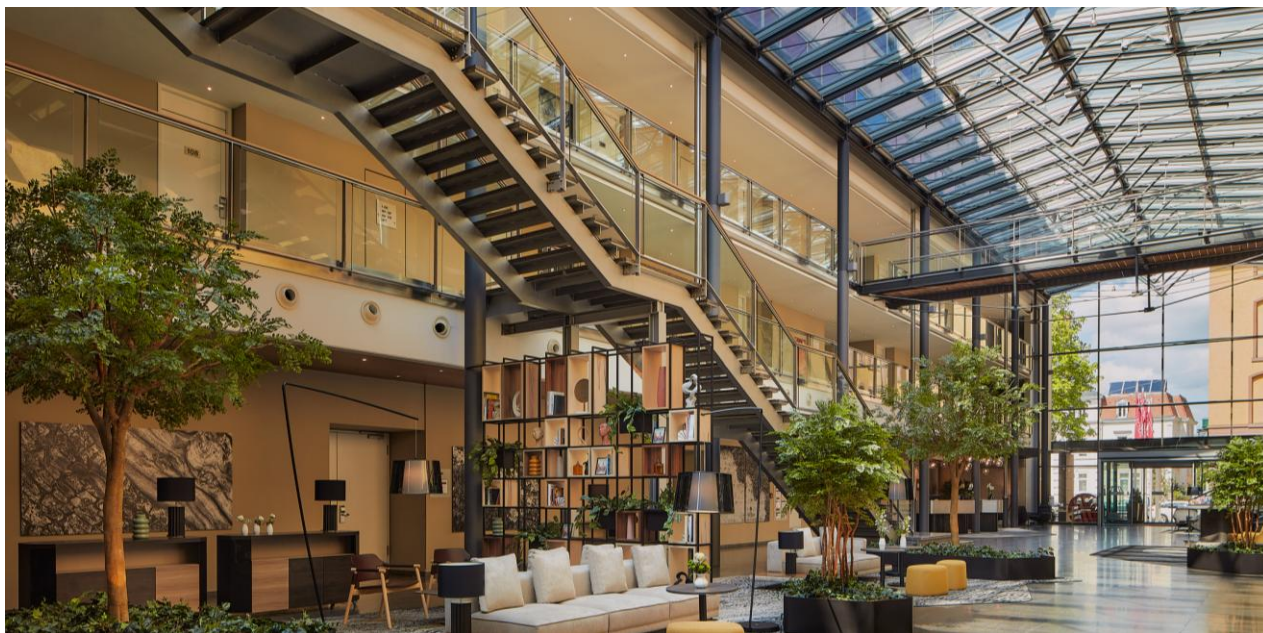


NH Collection Heidelberg

NH Collection Heidelberg is located in the quiet Bergheim district, just a few minutes from the old town with its castle and the old university.

The hotel has 168 rooms spread over the new extension and the historic part of the former Heidelberg Brewery. The 168 rooms and suites are modern and comfortable. Contemporary in style, they have a luxurious feel with brown and grey décor and wood and metal accents. Imaginative artwork completes the room design.

It is said that the lobby is haunted by the ghost of the old master brewer, Friedrich Kleinlein. We cannot promise that you will meet him, but legend has it that the ghost of the old brewmaster is still ever-present. The old cast iron staircase in the lobby, which used to be a secret spiral staircase to the distillery, is regularly visited by Friedrich.

Location

Prime location close to the old town



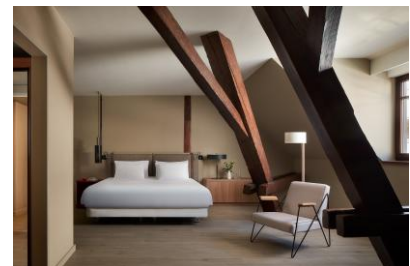
Heidelberg is truly a hidden gem in the Neckar valley. Home to Germany's oldest university, dating back to the 14th century, and famous for its Baroque old town, the city enjoys a privileged location, surrounded by woods, with a beautiful riverside setting and an evocative hilltop castle that attracts 11.9 million visitors a year.

Heidelberg has also been a centre of the arts for centuries, especially literature, and has been designated a 'City of Literature' by UNESCO.

Situated on the main street of the peaceful Bergheim district, NH Collection Heidelberg is just a short walk from the historic city centre with its castle and ancient history. Small shops, trendy cafes and cosy restaurants can be found on the way to the city centre. There is a tram stop just 200 metres from the property. This allows culture lovers to reach the historic city centre even more quickly, while nature lovers can explore the beautiful Neckar River within walking distance of their temporary home.

History & design

A place steeped in history



The history of this hotel dates back to 1753, when the Kleinlein family established a brewery on Heidelberg's main street. In 1870, the family purchased the hotel's current location on Bergheimer Strasse in order to expand the business.

In 1884 construction began on a fermentation cellar, which was expanded to over 11,000 square metres in 1927 with the addition of another building. The brewery was successful until the 1990s, when new technology and a new competitor nearby put an end to the business. It was time to say goodbye to the historic Heidelberg Brewery.

In a new chapter for the establishment, a small group of architects combined the historic building with a new building to create a sophisticated hotel with a breathtaking glass-roofed lobby atrium. The dialogue between modernity and tradition has formed the basis of the 2023 renovation, further creating a unique hotel in the heart of Heidelberg.

The historic part of the hotel retains much of its brewery history and charm. The old cast-iron staircase in the lobby once led to a secret spiral staircase leading directly to the distillery. The award-winning design, which harmoniously blends old and new, allows hotel guests to feel the soul of the city.

Restaurant & bar

A place for gourmands



For breakfast, NH Collection Heidelberg offers a tempting, extensive buffet with fruit, yoghurt, pastries, cold cuts and various cheeses. Guests can also order freshly prepared eggs. On weekends and public holidays, the hotel also offers a children's breakfast. An early bird breakfast option is available for guests departing before the restaurant opens.

Drinks and snacks are available at the bar, which is open from early morning until late at night. You can choose from cocktails, wine and of course local Heidelberg beers.

Modern equipment and light-flooded rooms



Located on the fourth floor in the historic part of the hotel, the gym is flooded with natural light thanks to its large windows. Equipped with the latest fitness equipment, it is open 24 hours a day.

The spa also offers a sauna, steam bath, spa showers and a relaxation area with thermal chairs.

An event at NH Collection Heidelberg is a truly memorable experience. The huge glass lobby provides a grand entrance for any event. The adjoining brewing cellar can accommodate up to 60 people for social and business dinners and features a historic copper brewing kettle. In addition to 16 meeting rooms, the hotel offers almost 1000 square metres of meeting and event facilities, making it one of the largest conference hotels in the city of Heidelberg.
