[NH Collection Palacio de Córdoba](#) invites guests to experience Córdoba at its most authentic, where centuries of history unfold effortlessly alongside contemporary comfort. Set within an elegant 18th-century palace, the hotel reopens 2026 with a refined new identity—one that celebrates its storied past while embracing a fresh, sophisticated aesthetic. It is a destination designed for travelers who value culture, beauty, and a sense of timelessness, without ever compromising on comfort or service.

In the heart of the historic Jewish Quarter, on Plaza de Maimónides, this five-star retreat occupies a remarkable collection of former noble residences dating back to the 17th and 18th centuries. Córdoba itself is a city without equal: the only city in the world to hold four UNESCO World Heritage designations, a rare distinction that reflects its extraordinary cultural depth and layered history. From here, the city's most iconic sights—the Mosque-Cathedral, the Andalusian House, and the winding streets of the old town—are just a leisurely stroll away, inviting guests to explore at their own rhythm.

History is not simply preserved here; it is part of the everyday experience. Sections of Córdoba's ancient city walls have been carefully restored and woven into the architecture, visible from various areas of the hotel and even from select rooms. The site itself tells a layered story, having evolved from a Roman *domus* to a Renaissance palace and later a noble residence, allowing guests to sleep quite literally surrounded by centuries of heritage.

Architectural details from the past are thoughtfully reimaged through a contemporary lens. Traditional courtyards, graceful arches, handcrafted woodwork, and decorative ceilings coexist with modern design, creating a calm, elegant atmosphere. At the heart of the hotel lies a striking Mudéjar courtyard, defined by its 16th-century brick arches—one of the most atmospheric spaces in the property—beautifully contrasted with the neoclassical façade added in later years.

Life at NH Collection Palacio de Córdoba flows around three quintessential Cordoban patios—Patio de Petra, Patio Mudéjar, and Patio del Compás. Filled with natural light, orange trees, and flowers, these serene spaces offer moments of pause and quiet, echoing the soul of a city shaped by Roman, Islamic, Jewish, and Christian cultures. From different corners of the hotel, guests can also glimpse the remains of the old walls that once enclosed the Jewish Quarter, a neighborhood renowned for its intimate scale, hidden courtyards, and enduring sense of history.

Services & Facilities

NH Collection Palacio de Córdoba reveals a new chapter of refined luxury in one of Spain's most culturally rich destinations. Set within an 18th-century palace in the heart of the historic Jewish Quarter, the hotel reopens as a serene urban retreat where architecture, interior design, and history converge with effortless elegance.

The property offers 108 rooms and suites, conceived as calm, luminous sanctuaries that balance heritage and contemporary design. The interiors are defined by clean architectural lines, soft neutral palettes, and carefully selected noble materials that echo the building's historic soul while introducing a distinctly modern sensibility. Every detail has been considered to enhance light, space, and comfort, creating an atmosphere that feels both timeless and quietly luxurious.

Accommodation ranges from Superior and Premium Rooms to Family options, alongside twelve individually styled Junior Suites and five expansive Suites, each featuring a separate living room and two bathrooms with both shower and bathtub. Among the most coveted stays is the Suite overlooking the Mosque-Cathedral Tower, offering sweeping views across Plaza de Maimónides and one of the world's most iconic monuments. Equally distinctive are the Suite facing the ancient city wall, immersed in Córdoba's medieval past, and the Suite with a private patio, a rare and luminous space that reinterprets the traditional Cordoban courtyard with handcrafted pebble-stone flooring and a deeply local aesthetic.

The hotel's public spaces have been reimagined as elegant extensions of the guest experience. The reception area, newly relocated and redesigned, introduces a contemporary welcome that flows seamlessly into the lobby and shared lounges, all shaped by natural light, lush greenery, and constant dialogue with the original architecture. The breakfast room elevates the morning ritual with à-la-minute preparations and a curated selection of premium, fresh products, reflecting NH Collection's signature approach to refined hospitality.

Well-being and leisure unfold at an unhurried pace. Guests are invited to relax in an outdoor swimming pool set within a traditional courtyard, a secluded oasis that captures the spirit of Andalusian living, or to maintain their routines in a 24-hour fitness center, designed to adapt effortlessly to each traveler's rhythm.

Gastronomic Offering

Each morning, the hotel presents a complete and well-balanced breakfast experience, combining an extensive buffet with a dedicated Fresh Corner featuring smoothies, fresh-milk shakes, and vitamin-rich juice cartons, alongside high-quality fresh products and healthy options. Guests may also order hot dishes prepared to order, while those with early departures can request an early breakfast in advance through reception.

The hotel's culinary proposition is further elevated with the opening of Tablafina, a refined dining concept that pays tribute to Spanish culinary tradition through a contemporary lens. Set within one of the majestic 18th-century noble residences that form part of the palace, the restaurant unfolds across three iconic Cordoban courtyards: Patio de Petra, the Mudéjar Patio with its elegant cloister, and Patio del Compás, which serves as the restaurant's main entrance from the emblematic Plaza de Maimónides.

Inspired by traditional Spanish taverns and *tascas*, Tablafina's menu brings together timeless classics—such as Iberian cured meats, artisanal cheeses, and premium preserves—with a strong local focus under the

section “Esencia Cordobesa.” Here, signature regional dishes take center stage, including salmorejo, boneless oxtail, and a special flamenquín. The offer is complemented by the Chef’s Suggestions, showcasing seasonal ingredients and creative reinterpretations of Andalusian cuisine, positioning Tablafina as a standout gastronomic destination within the city.

With seating for approximately 90 guests, Tablafina Córdoba offers a distinctive setting where history and contemporary design converge, creating a memorable dining experience. Following its opening in Córdoba, this gastronomic concept arrives in the third major Andalusian capital, further expanding a journey already established in four Spanish cities.

Meetings & Events

The hotel offers two versatile meeting rooms, equipped with movable partitions that allow them to be divided into separate spaces or combined into one larger venue, adapting seamlessly to the specific needs of each event. These rooms are ideal for everything from small training sessions and board meetings to product presentations or conferences, with a maximum capacity of up to 80 attendees.

For more informal gatherings or social occasions, the hotel also makes its outdoor courtyards available—exceptional settings for events with a relaxed atmosphere. These spaces can be enhanced with tailor-made catering services, offering a distinctive backdrop where historic surroundings and contemporary hospitality come together to create memorable experiences.
