The hotel

The **NH Collection A Coruña Finisterre** is located right in the city centre, making it the ideal destination for both leisure and business travellers. Guests staying in this five-star establishment can visit the old town, located just a few minutes from the hotel, and enjoy the city's cobblestone streets and temples, including the Colegiata Santa María do Campo, a medieval temple with a Romanesque façade, Santiago Church, which dates to the seventeenth century, and the Santa Bárbara Convent, built in the fifteenth century. The establishment is also just a few steps from the Palexco Convention and Exhibition Centre and the harbour, the perfect spot for a relaxing walk evoking the city's seafaring history.

Coruña is famous for its *galerías*, the beautiful glass-enclosed balconies that make its buildings' façades so unique. On La Marina Avenue, opposite the harbour, there are many fine examples of these *galerías*, which give the city its nickname of the City of Glass. Dusk, when they reflect the setting sun, is the best time to see them. Several rooms at the NH Collection A Coruña Finisterre offer views of these glass balconies.

Services and facilities

The hotel has 92 elegant rooms, decorated in soft hues, with magnificent sea views. For an extraordinary stay, guests can choose from junior suites, which can accommodate up to four guests, superior rooms, regular suites, the ultra-luxurious presidential suite and a number of rooms designed for families, including four-person and adjoining rooms.

This hotel's exclusive services include an Olympic size outdoor pool with spectacular sea views, a salt-water swimming pool and a children's pool. For sports lovers, the Metropolitan La Solana Centre has tennis and padel courts which are free of charge for hotel guests.

The NH Collection A Coruña Finisterre has a dedicated Guest Relations Manager whose mission is to help guests with anything they need, such as booking tickets for shows and other activities going on in the city, arranging laundry services or hiring bikes.

Food and drink

In order to further enrich the guest experience and provide food befitting of a five-star establishment, the hotel has designed a unique gastronomic offering. To start the day with a healthy and balanced meal, the hotel offers a buffet breakfast with a wide variety of freshly-squeezed juices, pastries, cold meats, cheese, fruit, yoghurt and breads, among other choices. Guests can also order their favourite hot dishes.

For later in the day, the NH Collection A Coruña Finisterre is home to a first-class restaurant called Novo, which specialises in traditional food from Galicia with a contemporary feel. A meal at Novo might start with some hand-cut *jamón ibérico*, served with local bread, baby scallops, baked octopus or crab stew. There are some excellent fish dishes to follow that up, like hake in herb sauce with sea urchins and pear or monkfish with razor-shells and seafood casserole. The choices for dessert include fried ice-cream, coffee and crème brûlée or strawberries with cream in crispy puff pastry and vinaigrette.



After enjoying a meal replete with local specialties, guests can end the day sipping a delicious cocktail in the modern first-floor bar, which is an oasis of calm.

Meetings and events



Thanks to its flexible capacity and practical location, the NH Collection A Coruña Finisterre is the ideal place for organising conferences or celebrating special occasions. The hotel has eight flexible function rooms with the capacity to hold up to 1,000 people, making it one of the city's most remarkable establishments for organising an event. It also has a number of smaller rooms which hold between two and 12 people, most notably the Victoria Room, whose +700m², over two levels, are bathed in natural light, with views over the Atlantic Ocean. The hotel's team of experts can provide audiovisual services, translators and sound technicians if needed to ensure everything goes off without a hitch.
