

Media Kit - NH Collection Cáceres Palacio de Oquendo



The hotel

The palatial former home of the Marquis of Oquendo, the refurbished stone building that is home to the [**NH Collection Cáceres Palacio de Oquendo**](#), is located in San Juan Square. Built in the sixteenth century, it was acquired in the seventeenth century by Pedro José de Ovando y Cárdenas and his wife, the Viscountess of Peñaparda de Flores, whose coat of arms is on display in the inner courtyard. The façade features, in addition to decorative bossage mouldings, the coats of arms of Ulloa and Narváez, which belong to the Marquis of Oquendo, who owned the palace until 1980.

The hotel is located just a few minutes from the old wall that surrounds Cáceres, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. From the hotel it is easy to move around the entire city, which is full of centennial towers, cathedrals and churches. It has 86 rooms with views over San Juan Square or a quiet inner courtyard. One of the superior rooms looks over the city's Arab wall. All of the rooms are decorated in pale colours and feature wooden furniture and floors, so evoking the cultural heritage of Cáceres.

Locally-sourced food and wine with designations of origin

The hotel restaurant, Tapería Yuste, is one of the city's highest-rated eateries. The dining room features a vaulted ceiling and large windows looking out over the church. It is a destination for tasting the region's famous foods, including *jamón ibérico* and *Torta del Casar*, the local cheese made from sheep milk, paired with Extremadura's protected designation of origin wine, Ribera del Guadiana.

In fact, *Torta del Casar* is the protagonist of the restaurant's newest dish: Torta del Casar risotto with wild mushrooms and toasted almond crisp.



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Meetings and events

The NH Collection Cáceres Palacio de Oquendo has three rooms for meetings, conventions and weddings with the capacity to accommodate up to 130 people. The hotel staff includes an event planner and all the required audiovisual equipment is on hand. The hotel courtyard is the ideal place for a relaxing coffee break. Lunches can be held in a number of places, including the meeting rooms, restaurant, cafeteria and terrace.
