The hotel

A spectacular mansion houses the five-star [NH Collection Madrid Paseo del Prado](#). This establishment is exceptionally located in the heart of Madrid's cultural riches, on the landscape of arts and sciences between Paseo del Prado and Paseo del Buen Retiro, recently declared a World Heritage Site, specifically a cultural landscape, by UNESCO.

The building, built in 1904 by the architect, Antonio Palacios, at the behest of the Count of Bugallal, was initially designed as a summer residence. Each room in the original building had a unique function, such as a living room, dining room, private room and service area, so that no two rooms were alike. The hotel's current entrance used to be the horse and carriage entrance. The building is listed on account of its architectural heritage so that its original design has been kept intact.

With views over the emblematic Neptune Fountain, this hotel is the ideal choice for those looking to visit the capital city's cultural treasures, such as the Prado, Thyssen-Bornemisza and Reina Sofía art museums. The Retiro Park, Madrid's green oasis, is just a five minute walk away.

The hotel is surrounded by some of the capital's most famous bars and restaurants and very close to its most central metro stops, Banco de España and Atocha, putting all of Madrid's tourist offering within striking distance.
