## By Air

- Victoria Falls International Airport (VFA) is the nearest airport, serviced by direct flights from Johannesburg, Cape Town and Nelspruit Road Transfer Time: Approximately 20 Minutes
- Harry Mwanga Nkumbula International Airport (LVI), Zambia Road Transfer Time: 45 Minutes
- Kasane International Airport (BBK), Botswana Road Transfer Time: 1.5 Hours


## By Rail

Rovos Rail luxury train service operates a four-day journey from Pretoria, South Africa to Victoria Falls town, Zimbabwe Road Transfer Time: 10 Minutes

Transfers to Zambia and Botswana involve cross border travel and travel times are subject to Customs and Immigration formalities at the relevant border posts.

Airport and Victoria Falls town transfers are conducted in closed, air-conditioned vehicles.

Visa costs and requirements are subject to change without notice. Travellers are responsible for checking on visa requirements with their local or nearest Zimbabwe embassy or consulate before travelling, ensuring that they are aware of the most up-to-date information.

6 Reserve View Suites can be converted into a triple, accommodating two adults and one child up to the age of 15 years. The child is accommodated on an extra bed.

Two sets of inter-leading Reserve View Suites include a triple suite and is ideal for families travelling with children (maximum three children) or four friends travelling together (maximum four adults).

Two Reserve View Suites are wheelchair accessible.


# Anantara Spa

# Climate

Zimbabwe is pleasant to visit all year-round with hot summers and mild winters. Water flow over Zimbabwe's side of Victoria Falls is permanent, with the volume changing according to the seasons.

The rainy season runs from December to May and the waters of Victoria Falls are at their highest. In October and November, it is dry and although the Falls are at their lowest, there is no dense spray. From June to August days are warm and the evenings cooler with little or no rain.



# Health information

**Malaria:** Anantara Stanley & Livingstone Victoria Falls Hotel is located in an area where malaria is prevalent. We urge guests to consult their doctors about malaria prophylactics before visiting.

**Yellow fever:** There is no risk of yellow fever in Zimbabwe. Proof of vaccination on applying for a Zimbabwean visa is only required if guests are travelling from, or through, a yellow fever affected country.
