## UNESCO World Heritage Luang Prabang

### DAY 1 | LUANG PRABANG

After exploring the UNESCO World Heritage town of Luang Prabang, you will be chauffeured from Avani+ Luang Prabang to the vessel.

Our first stop is Ban Xang Khong, known for its traditional saa paper. Enjoy a hands-on experience making the paper from tree bark, fresh flowers and leaves, followed by the tasting of tea from Phongsaly, a northern Laos village.

Next, transfer in a longtail boat to the Nam Ou cliffs for breathtaking sightseeing before continuing to the legendary Pak Ou caves.

### DAY 2 | THE LOWER MEKONG

We drift downstream past lush jungle and charming villages, arriving at Ban Chan, renowned for its pottery. After a warm welcome from the locals, learn all about traditional pottery techniques before trying your hand at creation.

In the evening, we moor at tranquil Ban Muang Khay.

### DAY 3 | KUANG SI WATERFALLS

In the morning, we explore the stunning Kuang Si waterfalls, travelling by minivan. Lunch is then served surrounded by nature by the

Tad Keo falls. The cruise continues, mooring for the night at Ban Thadeua.

### DAY 4 | XAYABOURY ELEPHANT CONSERVATION CENTRE

Known as 'The Land of a Million Elephants', Laos takes pride in its



majestic creatures, and today, we visit the Xayaboury Elephant Conservation Centre, a genuine sanctuary dedicated to their preservation.

We then cruise through a passage in the Xayaboury Dam, getting an inside look at the workings of this unique landmark as we navigate through its locks.

#### DAY 5 | PAK LAY

We sail further, then take a scenic walk through Ban Niam and Pha Liep Village before continuing to Pak Lay.

Delight in a captivating cocktail hour as you take in the breathtaking sights of Ban Pha Liep, a charming village nestled alongside majestic limestone cliffs.

On your final evening aboard, enjoy a captivating traditional Lao dance performance.

#### DAY 6 | VIENTIANE

Disembark at 8:30 am in Pak Lay with a comfortable transfer by coach to the rich historic town of Vientiane.

#### DAY 1 | VIENTIANE

We depart from Le Thatluang D'oR Boutique Hotel in Vientiane at 8:30 am with a comfortable coach transfer to the vessel.

Boarding in the afternoon, you will enjoy a welcome briefing with refreshments followed by a delightful lunch.

As the cruise begins, relax with cocktails and nibbles while admiring the lush jungle of Pak Lay. We will moor overnight at Pha Liep Village, where you can explore the impressive limestone cliffs and cave.

#### DAY 2 | THE UPPER MEKONG

We glide past lush scenery and picturesque riverside villages, pausing for a scenic walk through Pha Liep, where you can soak in the local charm and atmosphere. In the evening, enjoy the refreshing river breeze as we moor at Ban Kok Fark and savour a themed dinner on the riverbank.


#### DAY 3 | XAYABOURY DAM

We begin the day with an invigorating walk in Ban Kok Fark, followed by a passage through the Xayaboury Dam. On board, enriching experiences including Laotian cooking and mixology classes, as we make our way to the serene mooring area at Talan Village.

#### DAY 4 | XAYABOURY ELEPHANT CONSERVATION CENTRE

Known as 'The Land of a Million Elephants', Laos takes pride in its majestic creatures, and today, we visit the Xayaboury Elephant Conservation Centre, a genuine sanctuary dedicated to their preservation. The centre also supports sustainable livelihoods

### DAY 5 | KUANG SI WATERFALLS

In the morning, we moor at Muang Khay Village to explore the beautiful Kuang Si waterfalls, following with a gourmet barbecue by the Tad Keo falls.

Back on board, watch a traditional Lao dance performance while enjoying cocktails, followed by a themed farewell dinner.

### DAY 6 | LUANG PRABANG

After breakfast, we will visit Ban Xang Khong, known for its traditional saa paper. Experience making the paper with natural materials and enjoy tasting tea from Phongsaly, a northern Laos village.

Disembark at 12:00 pm in the UNESCO World Heritage town of Luang Prabang, with a transfer to your hotel.
