A DISTINCTIVE ARTISTIC HERITAGE

In tribute to its origins the hotel was named after the Gaddi family, an important Florentine family of aristocratic origins and very well-known in both the Middle Ages and the modern era.

The Florentine branch of the family was important, first and foremost, as a painter dynasty, active from the 13th to the 15th centuries. The first of these was Gherardo Gaddi, Cimabue's pupil, while Gherardo's son Taddeo was Giotto's main assistant and worked on some of the Giotto school's greatest masterpieces.

Taddeo's son, Agnolo Gaddi, was also a painter, one of Florence's leading lights in the 14th century, together with his brother Giovanni. If you visit Santa Croce you may come across the fantastic work of Taddeo and Agnolo Gaddi, in the sublime Cappella Baroncelli. In the 18th century the Gaddi family had a larger and more sumptuous townhouse built on an earlier building they had purchased.

The building was adjacent to a famous garden called "Paradiso dei Gaddi" as John Milton eulogised it, with rare plants stretching out in an irregular trapezoidal form between Via del Giglio and Via del Melarancio. It is believed that Milton was a guest at the townhouse and wrote his famous Paradise Lost there, the facade bears a plate remembering his

stay at the house in the 1638-9 period. Inside the house, it is impossible not to notice a large extra-high hall (originally the gallery) with a vault frescoed with the majestic Gaddi family Glorie.

Later the Gaddi family bought Palazzo Arrighetti and incorporated certain portions of neighbouring houses into it to create a single building. The two Gaddi and Arrighetti buildings were nominated national art heritage sites in 1901 by Direzione Generale delle Antichità e Belle Arti.

The former Arrighetti building has a markedly imposing facade dominated by a shield bearing the Arrighetti coat of arms (silver lilies against a blue background and a diagonal gold band supplemented by two branches interwoven with green).

The main door opens on an atrium which leads, in turn, to a monumental staircase featuring a Resting Hercules sculpture along its bannisters.

The piano Nobile comprises magnificently frescoed rooms of which the frescoed ceiling attributed to Luca Giordano, supplemented by paintings and stucco work and dating to 1735, stands out.

Commissioned by the noble Gaddi family in the late 1500s, Tivoli Palazzo Gaddi Firenze offers palatial living in the centro storico of Florence.

The location is unrivalled, only 100 metres from the Basilica di San Lorenzo, 250 metres from Santa Maria Novella, and within a kilometre of the city's must-see museums and the Ponte Vecchio.

Our guests enjoy 86 elegant accommodations and the dedication to service for which Tivoli is known, exquisite cuisine by Chef Iside de Cesare of Michelin-starred La Parolina fame, and perhaps most memorable of all, daily aperitifs on the rooftop overlooking the city's most iconic landmark, the Duomo of the Santa Maria del Fiore.

Our hotel also plays host to elegant events, with a ballroom and series of salons adorned with the artworks of Niccolò di Sinibaldo Gaddi, one of the greatest collectors and patrons of his time.

L O C A T I O N

Located in the heart of Florence, overlooking its famed Duomo and only 5 minutes from the Cathedral, the Medici Chapel and the Galleria degli Uffizi, Tivoli Palazzo Gaddi Firenze has a strong sense of belonging generated by its historic Florentine architecture. Originally made up of two historic buildings belonging to two aristocratic Florentine families, the Gaddis and the Arrighettis, it has recently been renovated by Patrizia Quartero and Guy Oliver, internationally recognized interior designers. The work of specialist restorers and local artisans sealed its bond with the city, offering timeless elegance in one of the world's most iconic destinations.

ARIA ROOFTOP BY ISIDE DE CESARE

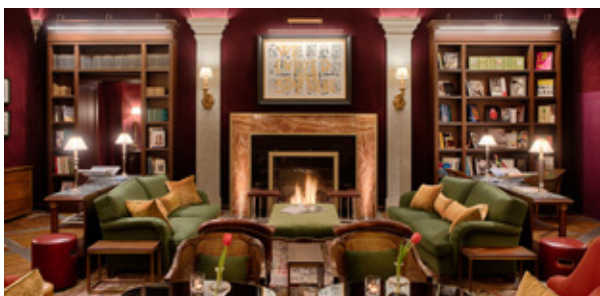
