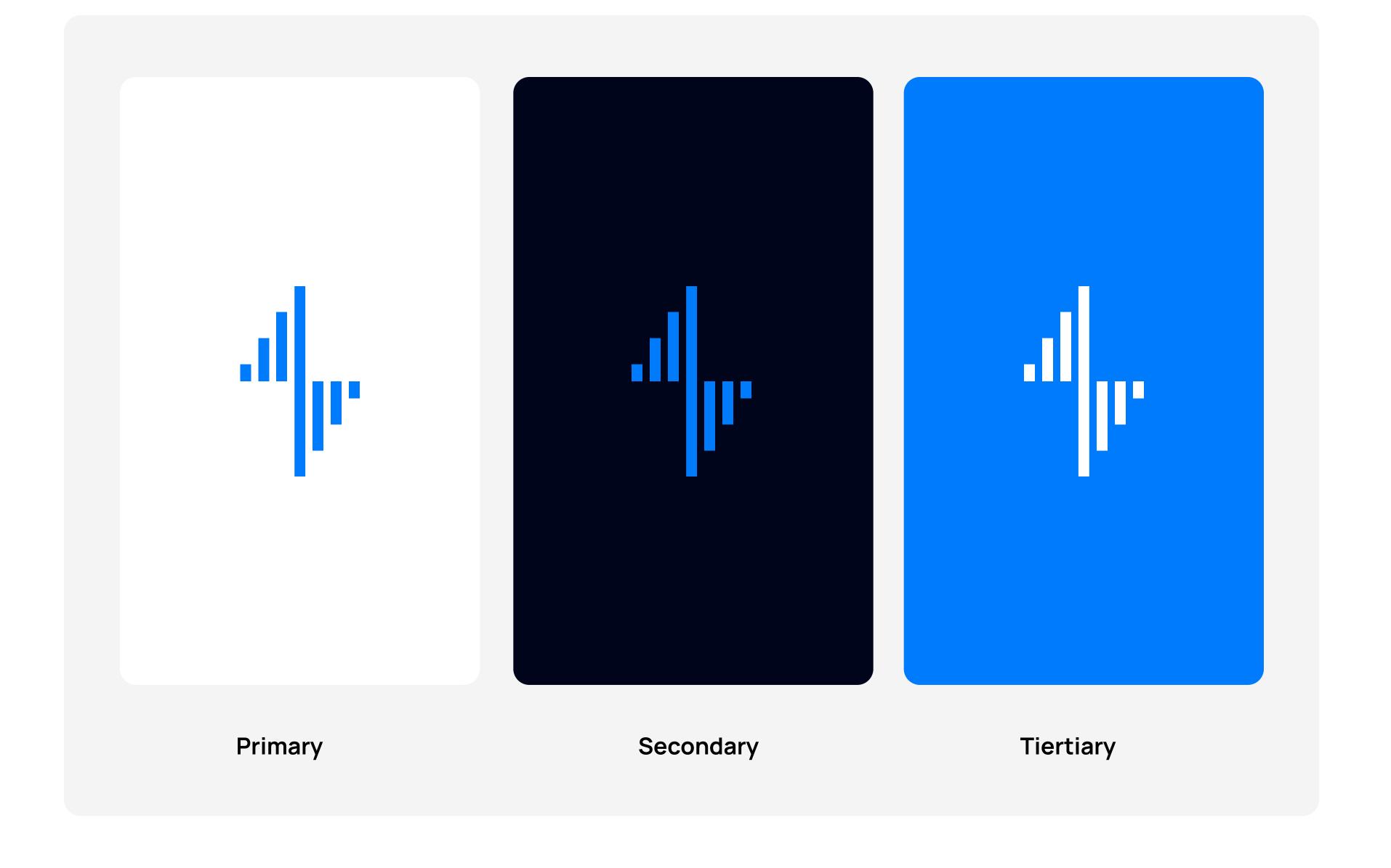

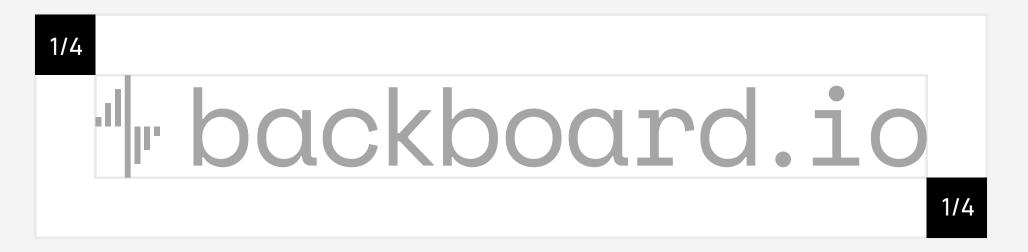

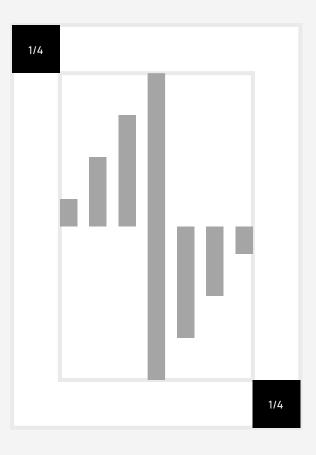
Logo Clearspace

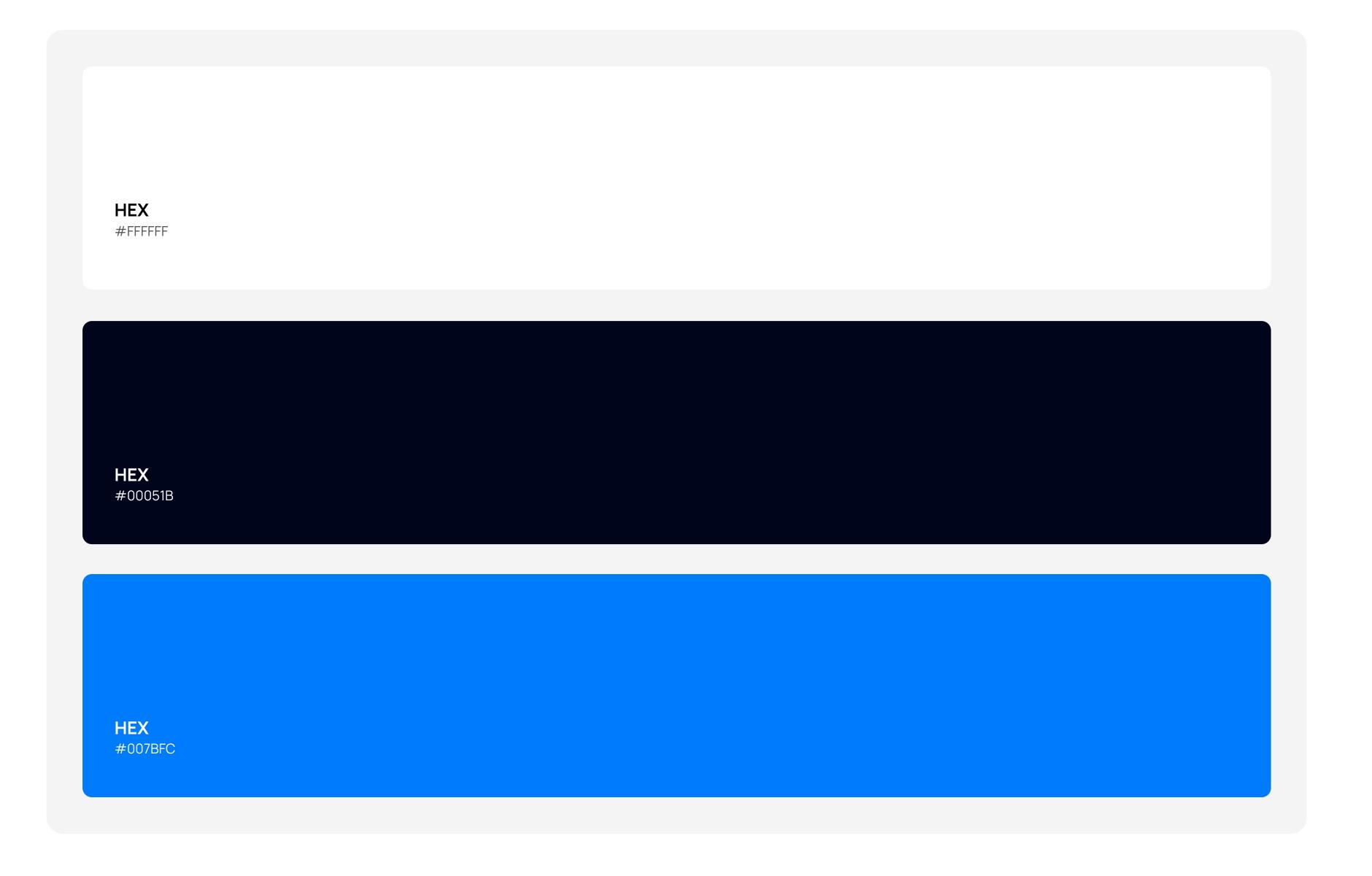

Primary Colors

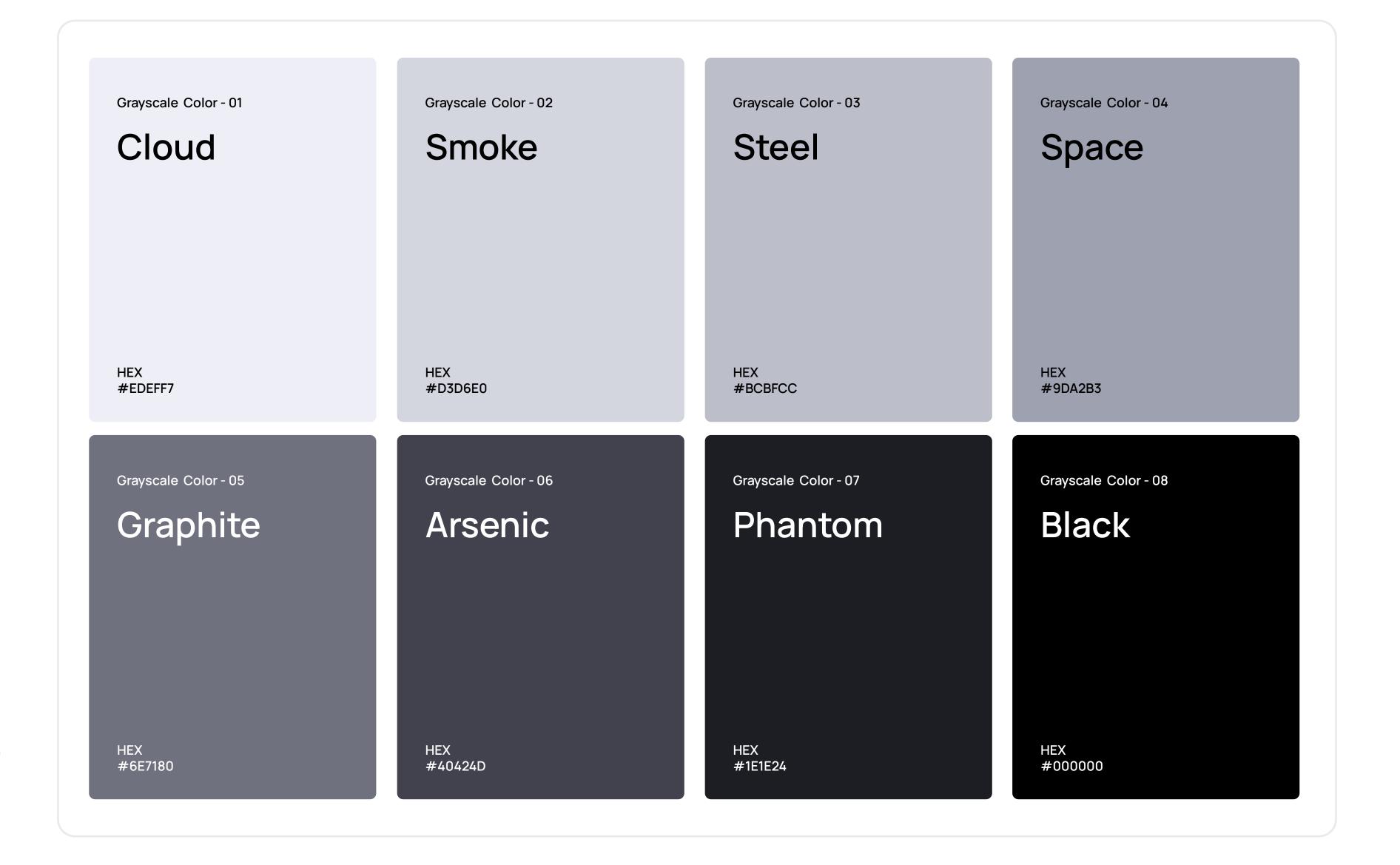

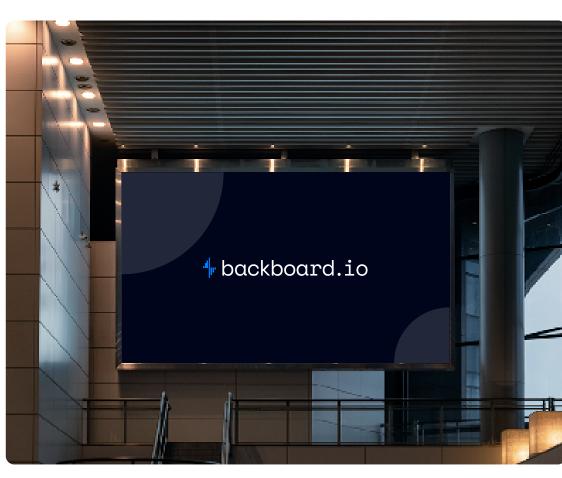
