U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Daniel Karafiat and his family were surprised with the gift of a lifetime during an emotional meeting at the national homebuilder's Georgia division office this month. The family will receive a brand-new Centex home in Bethlehem, Georgia. This is the Company's 10th year of providing homes to veterans and their families with gratitude for their service to our nation.
